Beal Building Tours

Please join members of the Beal Building Committee on Tuesday, November 15th and/or Tuesday November 29th from 7:30-8:30 p.m. for a tour of the Beal Facilities. This tour, open to the public, will provide an inside look at the 1922 facility and how it is currently used to serve our community. Members of the Beal Building Committee will be present to discuss the Beal Building Project leading up to Town Meeting on December 5th.

November PTO Meeting

Please join us this upcoming Tuesday, November 15th for our November PTO Meeting. This event will take place from 6:30-7:30 p.m. in the Beal Gymnasium. Childcare and treats will be made available. This meeting will transition directly into the tour of the Beal Building for those interested.

Veteran's Day Ceremony

There is no school tomorrow, Friday, November 11th as we celebrate Veteran's Day. There will be a dedication open to the public beginning at 11:00 a.m. at the World War I memorial in front of Beal to pay respects to those who have served our country. This memorial sits in the same location that the original 1924 World War I memorial sat for decades, but was taken down due to the deterioration of the foundation and materials over time. The new memorial, completed in 2013, strategically sits in front of the school named after Howard Beal, a World War I physician from Shrewsbury who was killed in action serving his country. Beal School, which has educated many students at various grade levels since 1922, has paralleled the monument outside and its namesake by promoting evolving skills and knowledge, civic responsibility, and the democratic process.
