

A Message from the Principals

Dear Beal Families, The next few weeks will be very busy with PTO sponsored events. Our Book Fair begins on Monday and culminates with a Weeding and Reading party on Saturday, October 21st. 
Our 3rd annual Beal fundraiser, the Beal Bop, kicks off Wednesday, October 25th! Beal School will team up with the Beal PTO to raise
