- 1. Balloon maker (1 or 2)
 - Spirit of Shrewsbury Fall Festival will supply you with balloons
 - You supply the talent to make animals out of balloons to give to children
 - Qualifications: Likes to dress up in a crazy costume to attract children; good at making balloon animals; funloving person
- 2. Costumed characters (20 people from 10 am to 3 pm OR 4 people per hour)

- 3. Bouncy house monitors (24 from 10 am to 4 pm OR for 4 inflatables and 2 hr. time slots (2 monitors per bouncy)

General help:

Volunteers needed to help unload and pack up vendor's items:

- Unload at 7:30 am
- Pack up at 4:00 pm
- Clubs that have a fundraiser at the Town Expo event are asked to help with the unloading and packing-up of all vendors.

Since non-profits do not pay a fee for attending, this is a way to give back.

Clubs can have tables for fundraising at no cost!

- Clubs must bring their own weighted pop-up tent for the Town Expo (see the *Spirit of Shrewsbury Fall Festival* website for details).
- If anyone wishes to be under the existing tent, the cost is \$50.

ALL CLUBS MUST HAVE AN ADULT PRESENT AND RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR GROUP.

Parade:

- Clubs/organizations are invited to participate in the parade on Sunday, September 25 at 1 PM.
- Participants are encouraged to dress in silly costumes or attire to make their club stand out.
- Signs/banners are also desired for each club in the parade.
- A registration form must be filled out (see Spirit of Shrewsbury website). An adult, whose name must be on the registration form, must accompany the group. No throwing of candy allowed.
