ASAP course: Science Sparkles: Fun with baking soda

Dates: 10/12, 10/19, 10/26, 11/2, 11/9 & 11/16

Instructor: Ms. Finn

Open to students in grades: 1, 2, 3 & 4

Course Description: Baking soda experiments are a great, safe and easy way to introduce the concept of chemical reactions to students with hands-on fun. Each week we will experiment with a new and fun activity documenting what we see - from chemistry in a bag, to erupting apples, and fizzy cloud dough, just to name a few!

ASAP Course: Monologue Workshop For Young Actors

ASAP course: Beginner Yoga for Kids
