

## Oak Middle School Musical Cast Expectations

1. Come to rehearsal prepared, focused and with your lines memorized.
2. Be ready to begin working at the scheduled start time.
3. All students involved with the production are required to pay the activity fee. All policies and procedures in your student handbook carry over to rehearsals and performances.
4. You must always have your script/music, a pencil, notepaper and water at rehearsal.
5. Wear loose fitting, comfortable clothing to rehearsal so you are able to move freely. You are required to wear sneakers or some other shoe that ties and provides ankle support. Bare feet, Uggs, flip flops, clogs and other such shoes are not allowed on stage. Hats are not allowed in rehearsals unless it is part of your character.
6. Cell phones and other electronic devices are not allowed during rehearsal.
7. The director is ultimately in control of the artistic decisions. This includes costume, hair, makeup and performance choices.
8. Any changes or additions to the schedule will be sent out via email. The most current information can always be found on the callboard outside 337.
9. **This is not negotiable!** Please be sure to practice good hygiene. Be sure to shower daily, including washing your hair. Wear clean clothes to rehearsal. Brush your teeth or use a mouthwash prior to rehearsal. Use deodorant and keep a stick in your bag to reapply as needed. It will be expected that you keep a stick of deodorant in your shoe bag once we are in costume. Please refrain from using heavily scented perfumes, colognes or beauty products.
10. When the production is over, you must return your script in the same condition you received it. Make all notations lightly in pencil. You will be financially responsible for scripts that are damaged or lost.
