


SAT Scales

Critical Reading + Math = 1600 scale


Critical Reading + Math + Writing = 2400 scale




Mean SAT Scores






SHS SAT Scores: 1-Year Comparison and 5-Year Trend



SAT Participation Rates of Local Districts




2015 SAT Comparisons--Local School Districts Critical Reading and Math Scores Combined




SHS Subject Test Scores Compared to MA and National Scores











AP Exam Participation Rates





2015 AP Exams – Local School Districts % of Exams with Scores of 3, 4, or 5


Maintaining and Improving Our Scores

- offered to all juniors and all sophomores




Maintaining and Improving Our Scores

 - Student participation has increased and is at its highest point for the past seven years.




