New extended day option provides more opportunities for working families

Added more STEM programming based on parent feedback

Self-funding Summer Programs provide affordable options for families

- \$80/\$34 (reduced) Half day enrichment
- \$165/\$69(reduced) Full day enrichment program
- \$95 Pre-School enrichment program
- \$95 Kindergarten Transition


