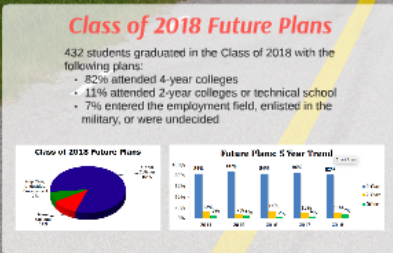

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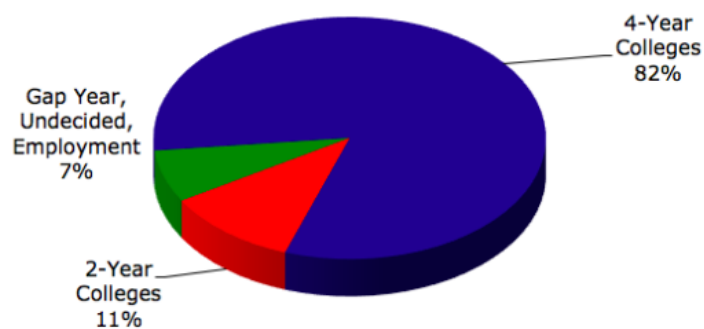


# Class of 2018 Future Plans

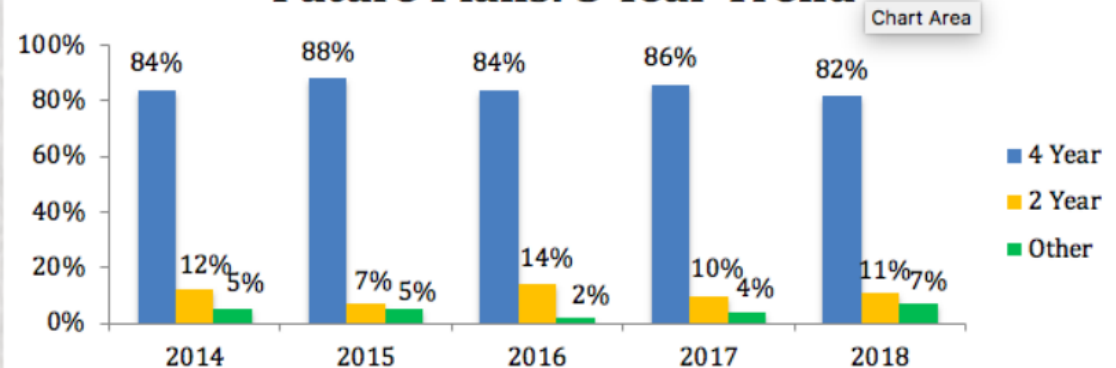
432 students graduated in the Class of 2018 with the following plans:

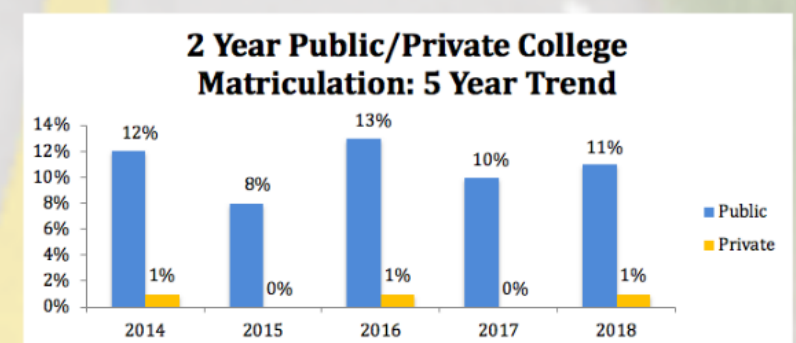
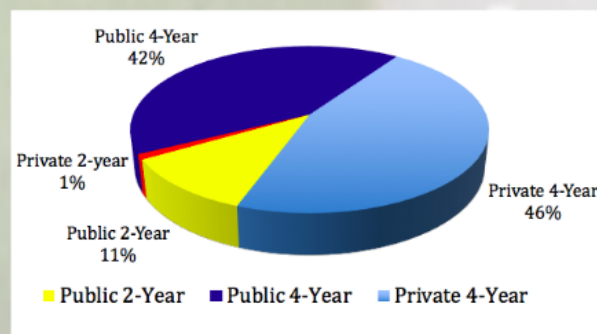
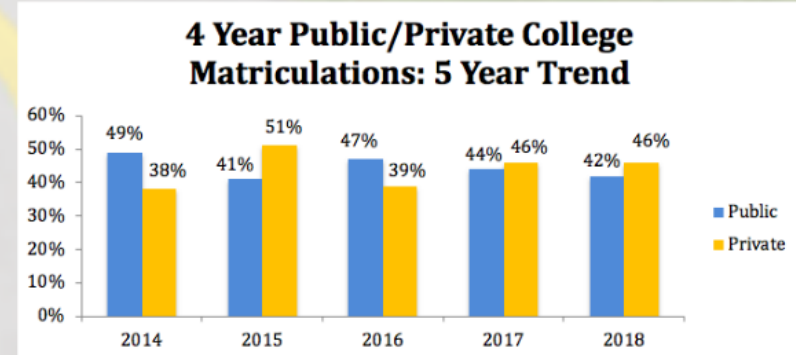
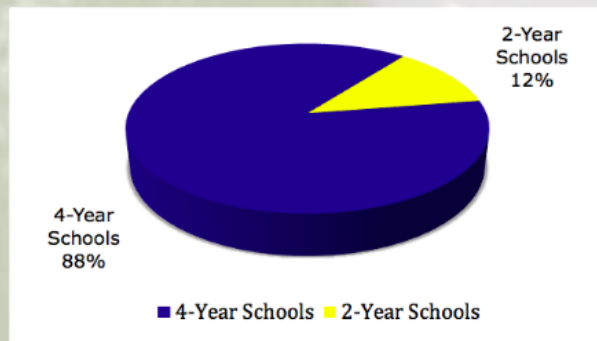
**Future Plans: 5 Year Trend**





# Public and Private 2- and 4-Year Matriculations

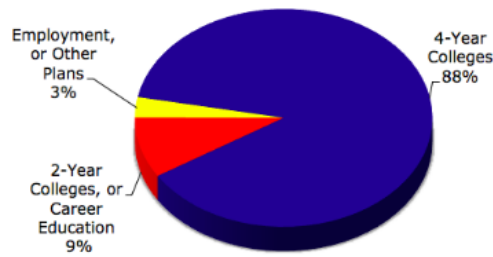
- 88% attended 4-year colleges and 12% attended 2-year colleges or technical schools
- 54% attended public colleges and universities; 46% attended private colleges and universities



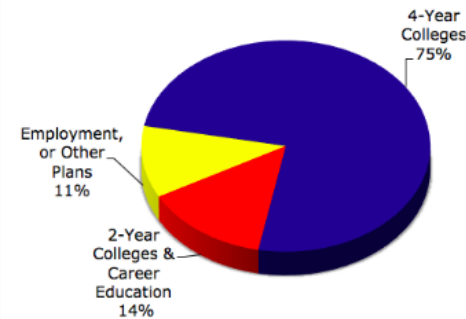
# Future Plans by Gender

The Class of 2018 consists of 243 females and 189 males.

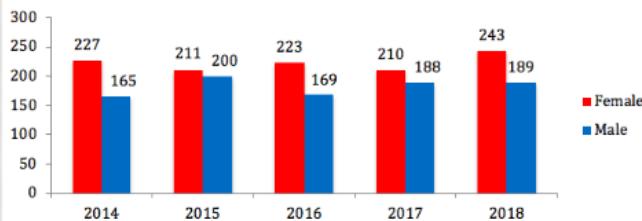
2018 Future Plans--Females



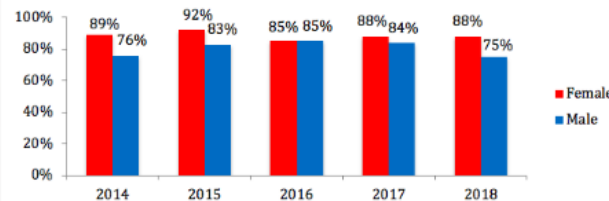
2018 Future Plans--Males



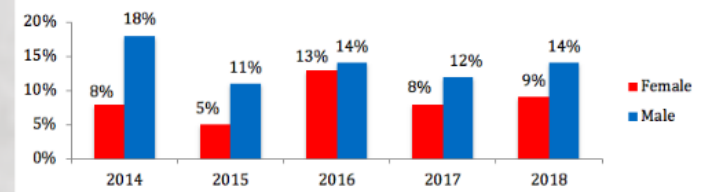
Total Enrollment: Gender



4 Year College Matriculation: 5 Year Gender Trend

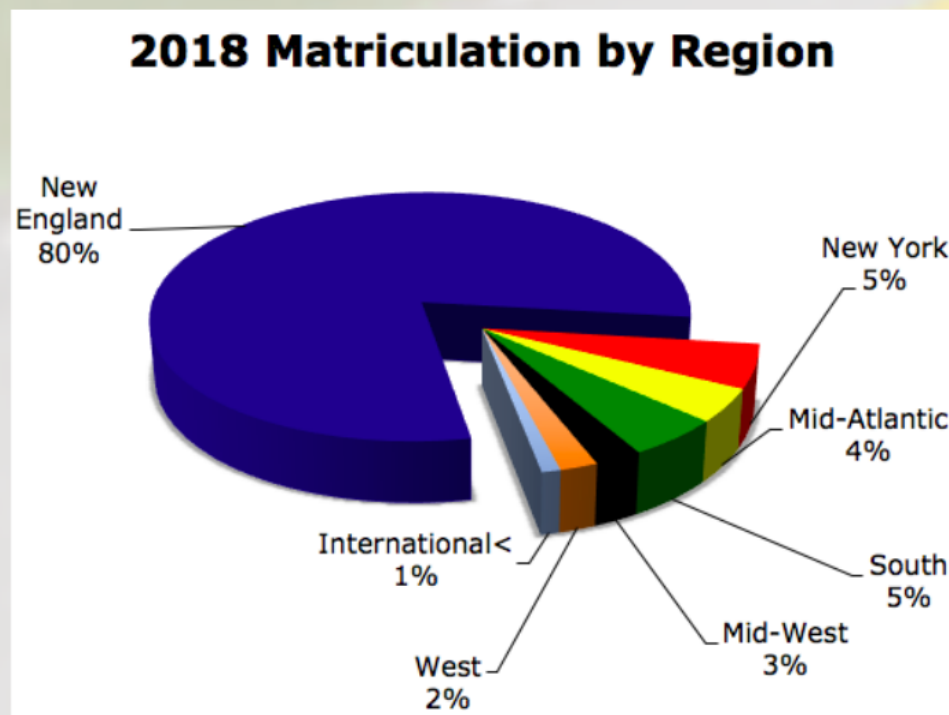


2 Year College Matriculation: 5 Year Gender Trend



# Geographic Breakdown

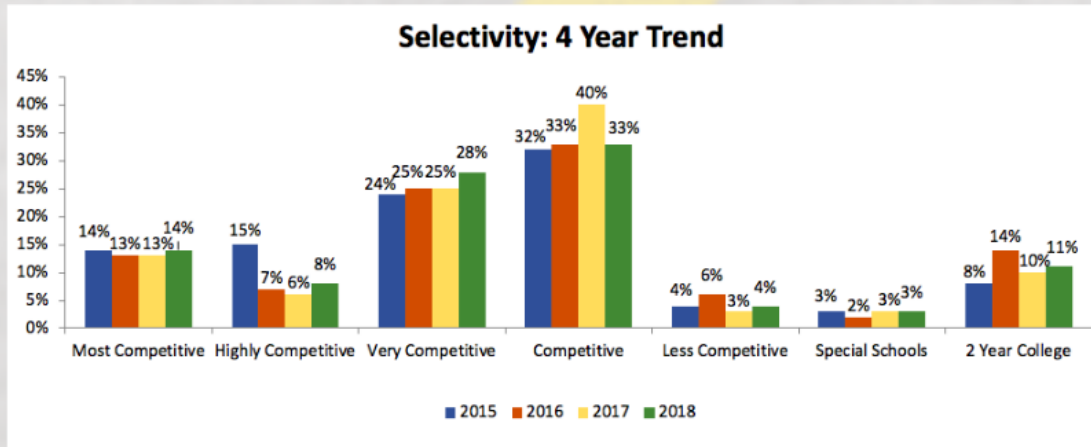
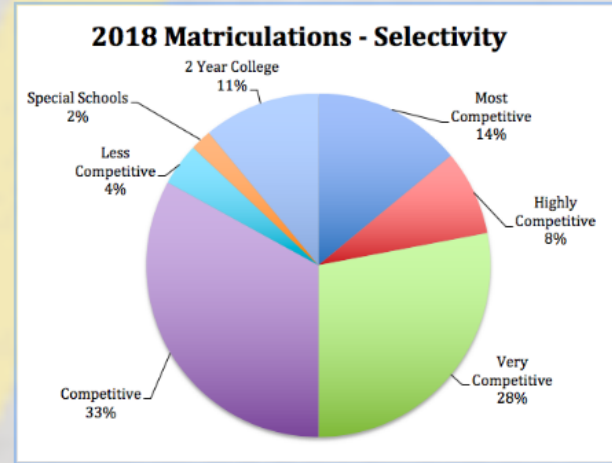
- Seniors in the Class of 2018 were accepted to 361 different colleges and universities in 31 different states, Canada, and Romania.
- Seniors in the Class of 2018 enrolled in 135 different colleges and universities in 29 different states, District of Columbia, Canada, and Romania.





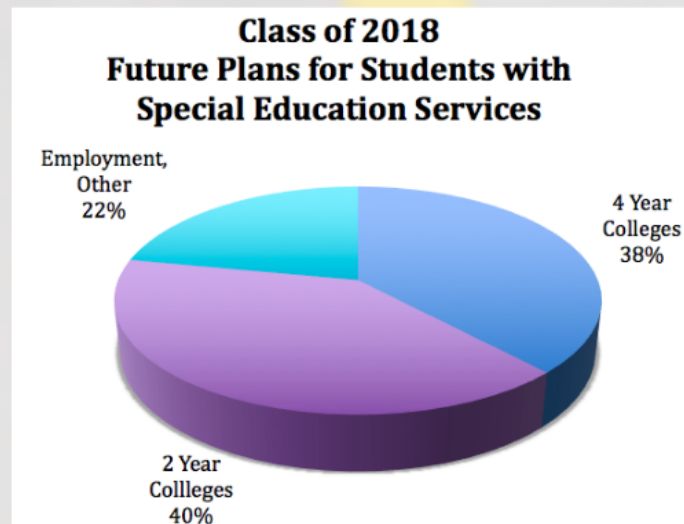

## *Future Plans of Students Receiving Special Education Services*

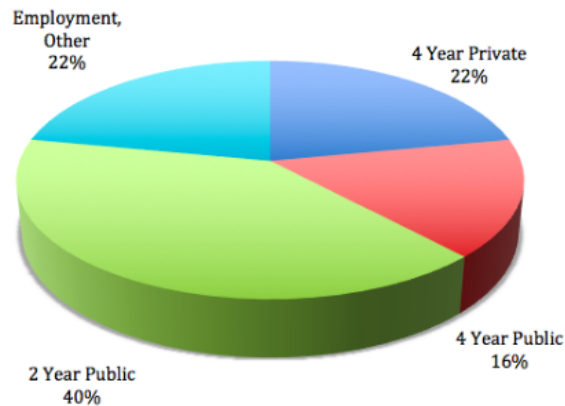
- Thirty-seven students (9%) in the Class of 2018 received special education services. Of these 37 students:

  - 22% entered the employment field or military



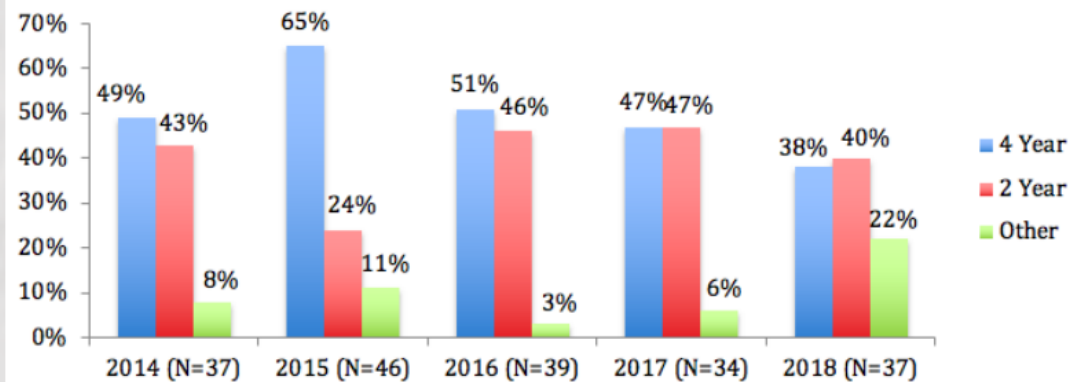
# Public & Private Matriculations of Students Receiving Special Education Services

**Students Receiving Special Education Services Matriculation: 5 Year Trend**

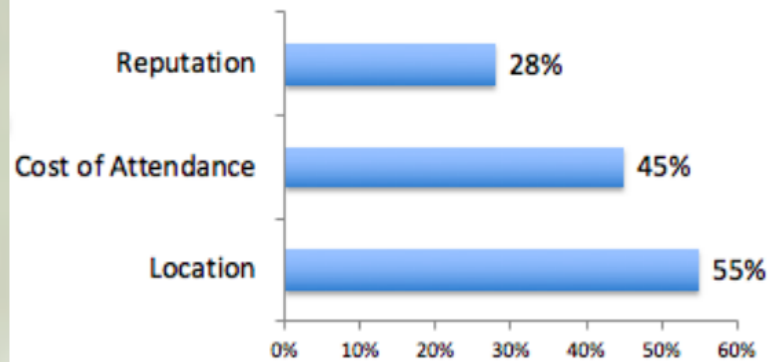




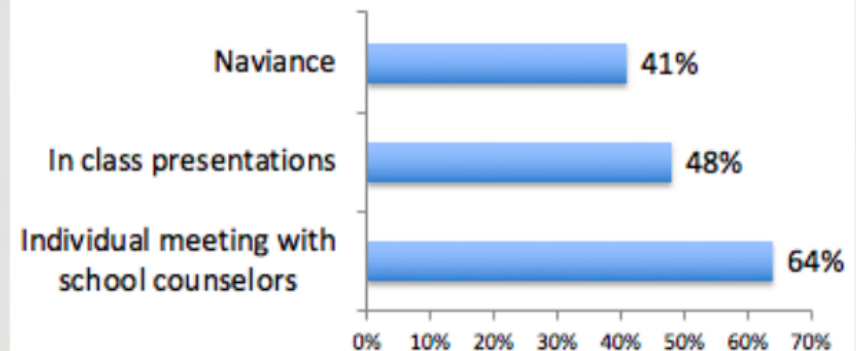

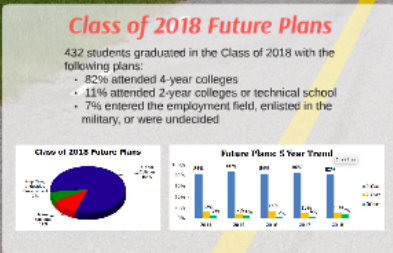
