Scouts are trained to camp safely in all four seasons, and the boys learn the importance of community service.

You'll also learn by earning Merit Badges such as Automotive Maintenance, Cooking, Disabilities Awareness, Engineering, Farm Mechanics, First Aid, Home Repair, Law, Medicine, Movie Making, Public Speaking, Robotics, Space Exploration, Sports, Theater, Veterinary Medicine, Weather, Welding, & Wilderness Survival, just to name a few!

Troop 1004 is sponsored by the American Legion who send two of our 11th graders to attend Massachusetts Boys States each year. We also send Scouts to National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) summer camp each year.

We are made up of approximately 35-40 boys with a strong tradition of producing Eagle Scouts. Since 1965, the Troop has helped 132 boys achieve the rank of Eagle.
