# Grade 3 through High School Registration Close: At Age Group coordinator discretion after January 1st, 2019

Below are some notes on the spring session. Please review these before registering. Please contact the age group coordinator for your intended registration should you have any questions.

## Pre-K through Grade 2

While late registration and registration closure dates are set for closer to the start of the spring session, we do request you register your players as soon as possible. Team creation and placement is an extensive process. With sooner registration we are more able to accommodate coach and player schedule limitations.

In the interest of player development, we are continuing to limit the number of requests for particular coaches or other players. If a specific placement request is of high importance to your family, please review the placement process at <a href="http://www.shrewsburyyouthsoccer.com/placement.htm">http://www.shrewsburyyouthsoccer.com/placement.htm</a> and coordinate with other families in advance of registering.

#### Grade 2 Format and Placement

We will be continuing our choice to have the Grade 2 teams play in a 6 v 6 format for the Spring season. This is an important part of the progression of

soccer skills through this age group and will introduce the concepts of formation, goal keepers and offsides all on a larger field.

Team placement will basically follow the U5 through U7 process but some accommodations for balanced competition may be made based on Coach Evaluations from this Fall Season.

#### Grade 3 and 4 In-Town

Our Grade 3 and 4 registrations have grown such that we anticipate offering an In-Town group for the Spring 2019 season. Having this opportunity to allow further development of soccer skills in an appropriately competitive environment is great but will depend on registration numbers.

If you would prefer your player to be placed on in In-Town team only, please check the In-Town ONLY option during the registration process. If you would like your player to be considered for placement on a Travel Team, please check the Travel/In-Town Option. Team placement will follow the U10+ team placement process which will consider the Coach Evaluations from the Fall 2018 session in addition to previous player evaluation information and team availability. Late registration fees will begin December 1<sup>st</sup>.

## Grade 3 through High School Placement

Placement on a particular team for the Spring Season will follow the Grade 3/4+ placement process. This process will consider the Coach Evaluations from the Fall 2018 session in addition to the previous player evaluation information and team availability. Due to player registrations and evaluations, we do not guarantee a particular team placement from the Fall to Spring seasons. Please consult the SYS Player Placement By-laws if you have questions. Late registration fees will begin December 1st.

## **Uniforms**

All Grade 3 through High School players wear the navy blue SYS Adidas uniform. Please order the uniform online during the registration process. Choose sizes carefully. Adidas sizes run small, so order the larger size if you are uncertain. Late uniform orders may be subject to a late/restocking fee. All Pre-K through Grade 2 players receive a new uniform at the start of each season.
