### **Shrewsbury Colonials AAU Baseball Program**

The Shrewsbury Colonials AAU baseball program had another successful season in 2019. The 2 teams (13U and 14U) played in the New England AAU league and they were both competitive with the 13U team advancing to the playoffs. In 2020, there will be a 14U team and 2 new teams added: 11U and 12U. Indoor training will continue to be at Hit Quarters in Shrewsbury from January into early April, incorporating a complete program with pitching and hitting instruction from qualified instructors. In addition, there will be a weekly "baseball-specific" exercise program at Peak Fitness in Worcester that will focus training on core strength, flexibility and speed. There will be double headers each Saturday and/or Sunday between early April into early June (11U and 12U) or early July (14U) for a 25-30 game schedule, including tournaments. This allows the boys to play in a highly competitive environment with little to no interference with the town baseball league.

The Colonials 2020 11U and 12U teams plan to hold tryouts on Saturday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>. 11U at 9:00am and 12U at 10:30am on the North Shore field (15 Parker Road, in back of SELCO). Players will be evaluated for available roster spots and notified of results shortly thereafter. Please see the attached registration and waiver forms for more information on the teams.
