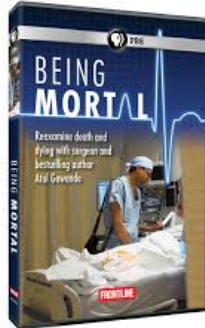


Screening of FrontLine/PBS Documentary “Being Mortal”
