Featured Speaker Commander Jamie Godwin, USN, Retired

Commander Jamie Godwin earned his commission through the US Naval Academy in Annapolis, MD. He first served as a Surface Warfare Officer aboard USS Peoria and USS Russell, a guided missile AEGIS destroyer, both in the Pacific Fleet.

He was then selected to attend naval flight school in Pensacola, FL and south Texas.

His aviation tours included deployments to Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan, Operation Iraqi Freedom, and Operation Joint Guardian in Kosovo. He then served as Executive Officer of the Naval Expeditionary Guard Battalion at Guantanamo Bay during a 15 month geographically isolated tour.

CDR Godwin selected orders to NROTC Holy Cross serving as Executive Officer, Commanding Officer, and faculty member. He then established the NROTC unit at Yale University as its Commanding Officer and a Professor Adjunct.

He retired from the Navy in 2015 after 30 years of service. He is married to the former Tonya Daniels Bryan of Denver, CO with whom he has four children; all of whom have graduated or will graduate from Shrewsbury High School.
