**MINUTES OF THE ELEMENTARY REDISTRICTING SUBCOMMITTEE**  
**October 27, 2020**  
**The meeting was held virtually via Zoom.**

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The meeting began at approximately 7:00pm.

The meeting began with a brief round of re-introductions since it had been six months since our last meeting.

Ms. Fryc and Dr. Sawyer welcomed the committee back from the Covid-related hiatus on this project. They explained that the new Beal School construction was on schedule and re-iterated importance of the redistricting work.

Ms. Hickey and Ms. Sankalia used a Powerpoint presentation to provide a re-orientation to the work and also an updated and now compressed schedule for the work to be completed.

Of specific note was an update describing the progress made in creating “components” which are the building blocks used to “mix and match” to develop options for new elementary zones. A sample new model was shown purely to demonstrate the “how” the work gets done and that spurred lots of conversation amongst the group. Mr. Collins committed to providing the committee with an electronic link that committee members could view and zoom in on the current components.

Mr. Collins indicated he would communicate the upcoming meeting schedule by the end of the week and that committee members should hold open Tuesday evenings.

The meeting then ended at 8:25pm.
