





## College Admission Trends

#### Applications have increased

- Total number of applications submitted increased
- Number of college applicants has increased
- Number of students deferred as increased especially for early action applicants
- College waitlists lengthened

Trend will continue to specifically in regular decision round which is why it's important for students to ensure that they have a balanced list of best fit colleges.

# **Application Process**

Research 10-20 schools

Apply to approximately 5-9

- Reach
- Target
- Likely
- Safety

Keep an open mind

Look for the best fit, not necessarily the best brand name

Best Fit = Social, Financial & Academic

# Components of the Application Process (Student)

- The Application
  - Common App, School Specific Application
  - o Essay
  - o Resume
- Standardized Tests-SATs & ACTs
- Letters of Recommendation

# Types of Applications

- Common Application
  - 700+ schools accept the Common Application
  - o Supplements
- School Specific Applications

\*\*Student submits the application online

#### SAT/ACT Scores

- What does test optional mean?
- When should a student send their scores?

\*\*We encourage students to speak to their counselor about whether or not to send scores

- Score Choice: gives students the option to choose which scores (by test date) to send to colleges.
- Students are responsible for sending their test scores to colleges, scholarships, NCAA, etc. - SHS are not allowed to send test scores to any organization at any time.

#### SAT & ACT Dates

- SAT Test Dates:
  - October 7: Deadline passed (at SHS)
  - November 4: Deadline to register-Oct. 5 (at SHS)
  - December 2: Deadline to register-Nov. 2
- ACT Test Dates:
  - October 28: Deadline to register Sept. 22
  - O December 9: Deadline to register-Nov. 3

#### Letters of Recommendations

- Counselor Recommendation
  - Complete Bio Survey in SCOIR
  - Set up appointment with counselor
- Teacher Recommendation
  - Follow the directions of college (1 or 2 letters only)
- Supplemental Recommendations:
  - Caution: does not replace the required counselor or teacher recommendation.
  - Colleges choose what to read
  - O Letters from an administrator are not considered a teacher or counselor letter.
- One Month Rule: Ask for letter at least 1 month prior to first deadline

Students submit an application by a specified date and receive a decision in a clearly stated period of time. Students make a commitment to a first- choice institution where, if admitted, they will definitely enroll.	Students apply to an institution of preference and receive a decision early. They may be restricted from applying ED, EA, or REA to other institutions.

# Early Decision

When to apply Early Decision

- -Binding agreement between SHS, the family, and the college
  - -Financial Commitment
  - -Extreme circumstance to get out of binding agreement

# **Application Deadlines**

- Early Action & Early Decision
  - O November 1 or November 15
  - o Early Action II: December
- State & Private Regular Decision
  - January 1-Mid April
- California State Universities (UC's)
  - November 30th

# SHS Application Procedures

- Counselor Meeting/ Forms
  - School Profile
  - Transcripts
- Parent/Guardian Brag Sheet (in SCOIR)
- Schoology: SHS Students → Resources → School Counseling Folder
- School Counseling Curriculum
  - Conducted in Senior English classes
  - SCOIR and Common App preparations
  - Senior Year timeline

### Transcript Request Procedure

- Transcript Request Meeting (Mandatory)
  - O Scheduled at least 10 school days before first application deadline
  - o \$5 per transcript
  - Forms that need to be completed
  - Transcripts will not be sent until payment is received with yellow payment slip

#### Deadlines

- Nov. 1: Oct. 15
  Nov. 15: Oct. 31
  Dec. 1: Nov. 14
  Jan. 1: Dec. 8
  Jan. 3
- Mid Year & Final Transcripts will automatically send first quarter and first semester grades to all colleges on file.
- SHS automatically sends the final transcript to the college the student has chosen in mid June.

# Support & Additional Information

- Research support services during college visit to assess if the program is a good "fit"
- Families are required to send their own documentation (IEP & 504) to the college directly during application process
- Students must self identify after arriving at college (even if documentation has been sent) and meet with students services to discuss accommodations.

### Roles in the Application Process

#### Student:

- Schedule an individual appointment with their school counselor
- Register for SATs, ACTs, and send scores
- Obtain letters of recommendation from teachers
- Complete applications, essays, supplements
- Submit applications online

\*\*Counselors are available during all lunches Monday-Thursday in the commons, until Oct. 19.

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# Roles in the Application Process

#### Family:

- Talk about options
- Review college choices & deadlines
- Schedule and visit colleges
- Schedule time every week to discuss the process
- Let student lead the process
- FAFSA & CSS Profile (mefa.org/events)

#### School:

- Counselor & Student meetings to guide and support the process
- Sending transcripts and other school information
- Sending letter of recommendations
