

The Easterseals College Navigator program assists students to advocate for their needs, identify barriers, and access college services and resources to successfully reach graduation. This program provides individualized services to college students with disabilities based on their goals, strengths, and needs to help them build lifelong skills. Services can be delivered in person, virtually, or through a hybrid model to best meet the student's needs.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students must meet one of the three criteria below:



ASD Diagnosis & Receive DDS Services



Students with Any Disability Attending a Partnering Community College



Students Enrolled in College with Any Disability

Services Include, but not limited to:

- Providing information to students and families about what to expect as college students
- Connecting students with on and offcampus resources
- Developing communication and selfadvocacy skills
- Helping students develop timemanagement and organizational skills
- Assisting students with accessing online databases (Blackboard, Moodle etc.)
- Supporting students with advocating for appropriate accommodations
- Practicing social skills & discovering new opportunities for socialization
