Science

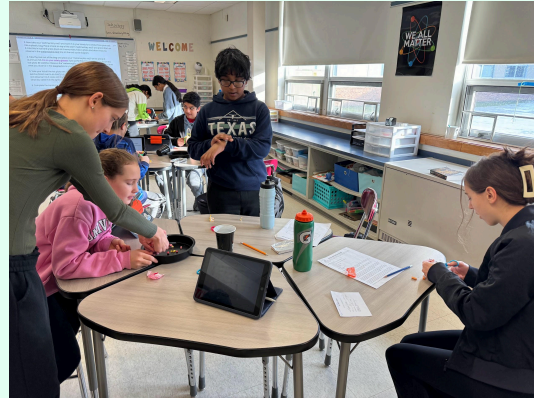
