

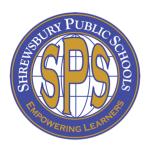
COVID-19 Closure Update

3 Messages:

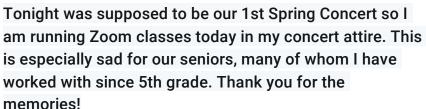
- We are here to support students academically and socially.

Grades K-5 & Grades 6-12

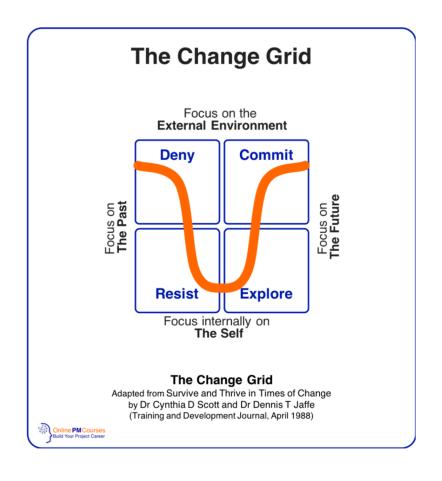
 Move all students toward successful engagement We think a focus on the prerequisite standards most critical to student success in the next school year will best support our students' learning.

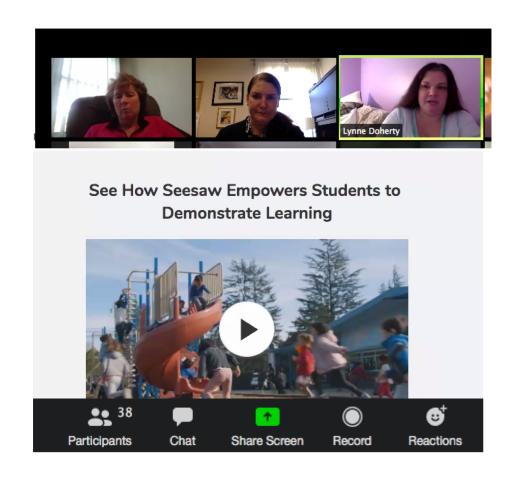
In short order, districts and schools should also expect to see separate guidance around critical operational matters related to closing out the school year remotely

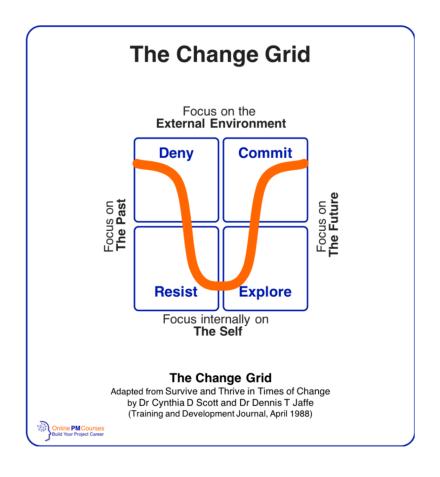

Special Education & Student Service VIRTUAL IEP/504 MEETING UPDATE

April 29, 2020

Virtual Meetings:Role of IEP/504 Team Members

- Staff will collaborate with parents and elicit input about student performance both before school closure and during remote learning
- IEP/504 team members report observations and data from when school was in session
- Base IEP/504 recommendations on observations and data, not on current presentation during school closure
- If needed, staff have been told that it is OK to turn off video after intros and/or briefly mute audio as needed for all participants



Prioritizing IEP/504 meetings

Meetings to Be Held Virtually



- Initial and Re-evaluations for evaluations that were completed before school closure
- Transition meetings for students identified as having high level of need (invite team chair from next level as needed)
- Annual Review Meetings in order of expiration
- Outside evaluations submitted to district
- Rejection Meetings on a case by case basis

<u>Considerations</u>

- DESE recognizes that not all timelines will be met
- Work collaboratively with parents on all issues



- Parents will need to consent to virtual meeting in writing (via email or signed consent doc)
- Virtual evaluations are not permissible at this time
- Parents will be given the option to attend via Zoom video or audio only
- Parents are allowed to decline virtual meetings. If so, we will hold a meeting when school resumes
- Propose that re-evals due during school closure are held at the time of the next annual meeting
- IEPs/504s proposed will be dated from the date of the meeting
- Team chair/504 Coordinator identify a team member to co-host
