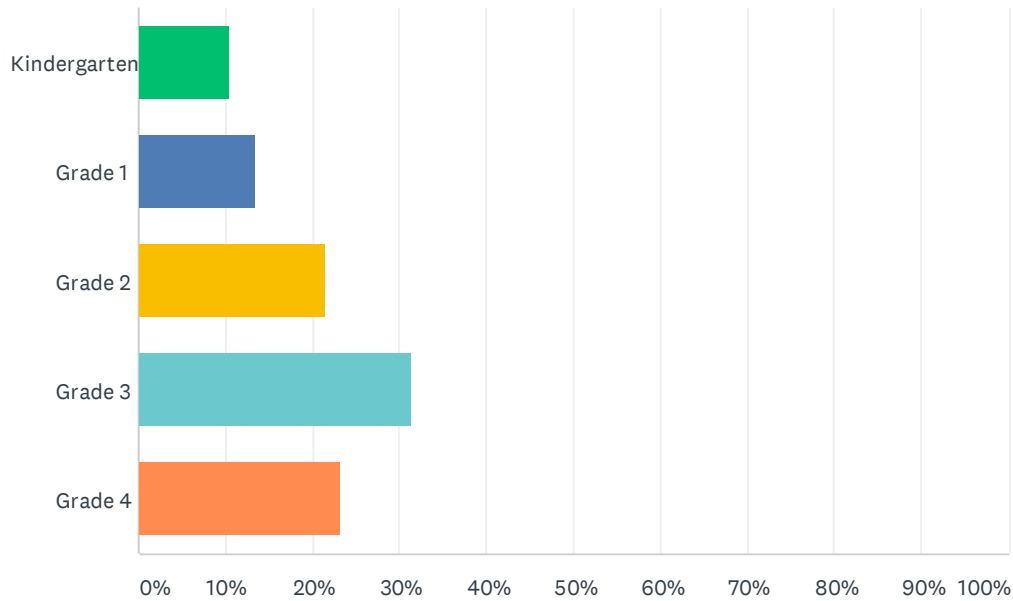

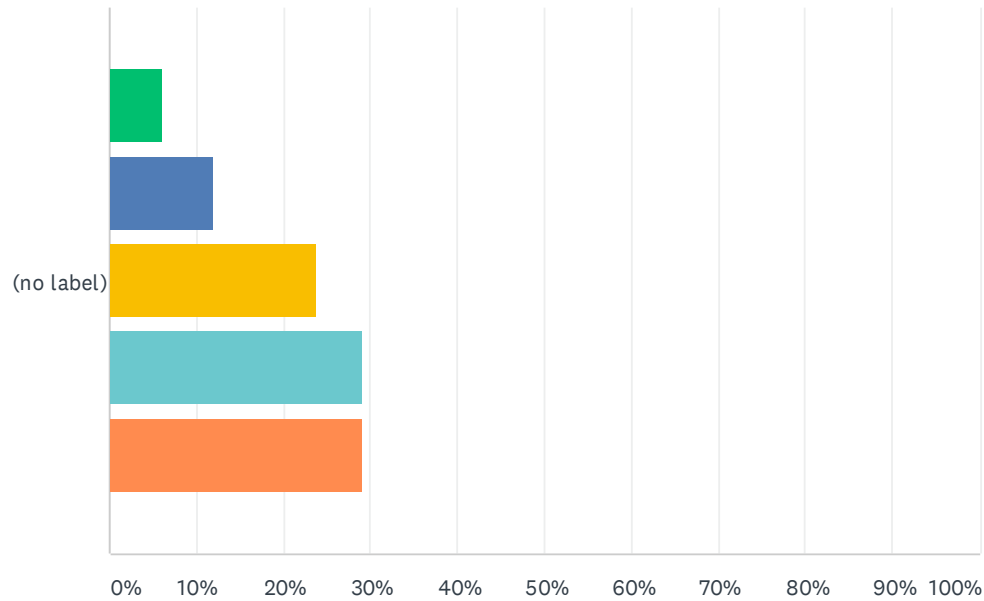

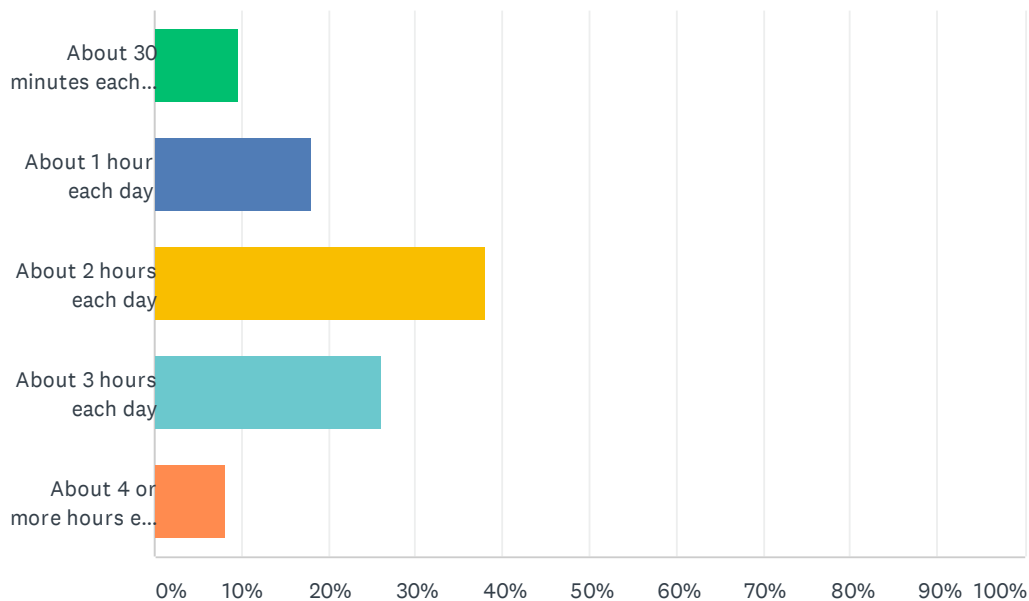

## Q4 My oldest/only child spends about approximately this much time to complete the daily Remote Learning assignments:

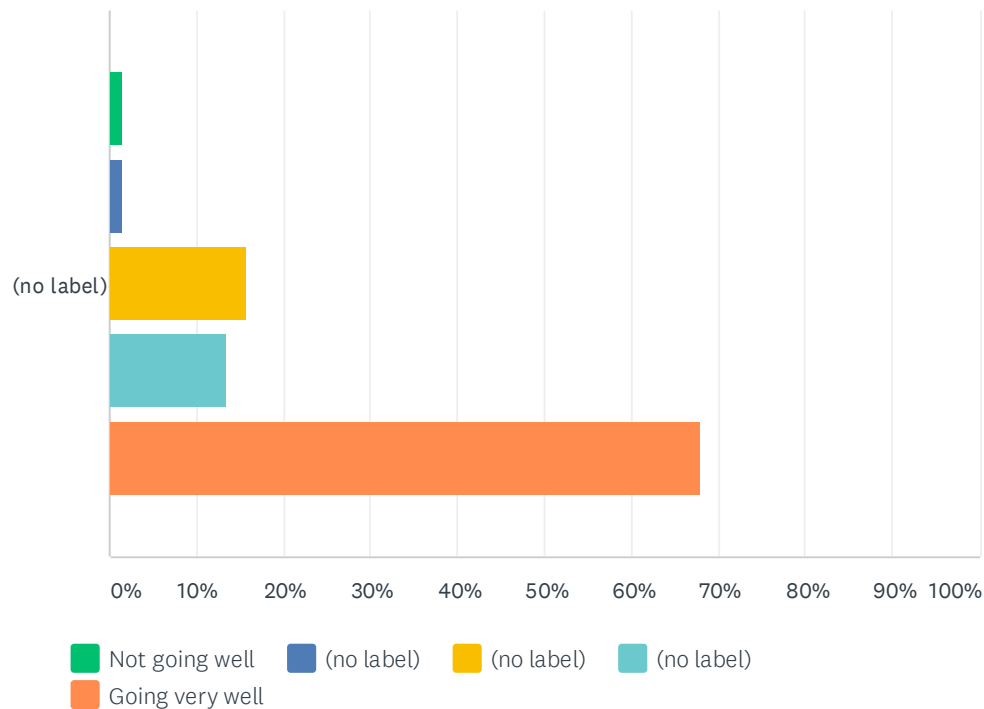

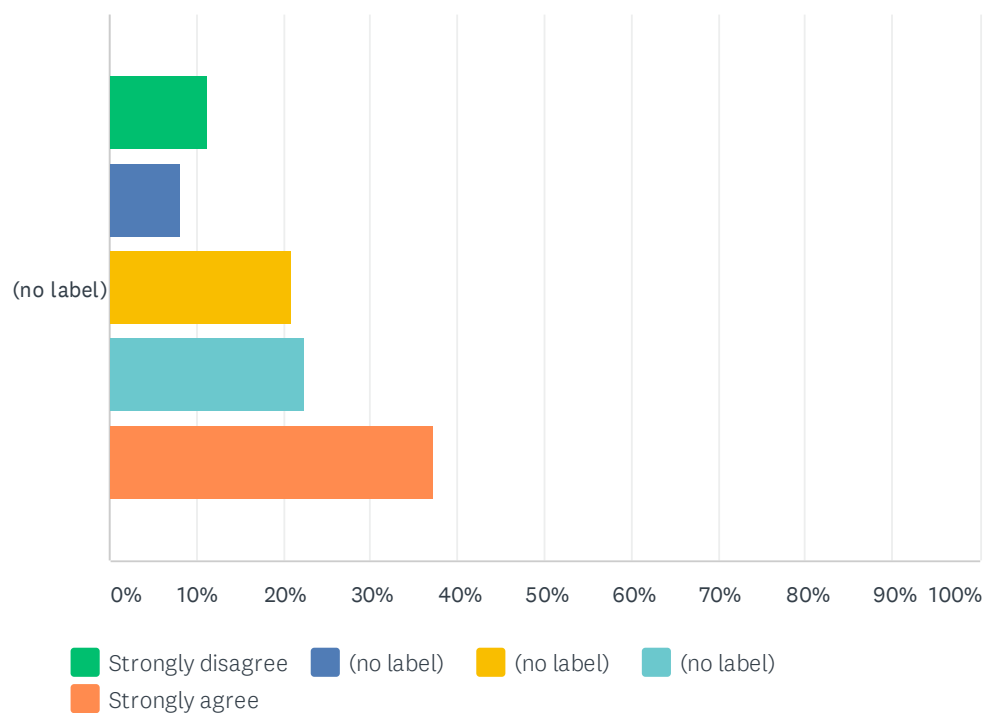
