

The Shrewsbury School Committee hereby:

- Condemns the murder of George Floyd that took place in Minneapolis, Minnesota on May 25, 2020
- Recognizes and condemns the ongoing impact of racism, both overt and structural, on black Americans that continues in our nation. All individuals and organizations, including Shrewsbury Public Schools, have an obligation to recognize and work to remove attitudes and barriers that lead to inequitable treatment based on race
- Recognizes that education is an important vehicle to address racism; we must better understand our history as it relates to racism, and engage in critical conversations on the topic
- Re-commits to the elements of our Shrewsbury Public Schools Core Values that our district:
 - honor each person's individuality, celebrate our community's diversity, and support school cultures of mutual acceptance and respect.
 - strives to create opportunities for all students to achieve success.
- Commits to supporting the Superintendent's announced intention that we will do better for our students, families, and staff members of color, and that a conscious and deliberate effort be made on that front
