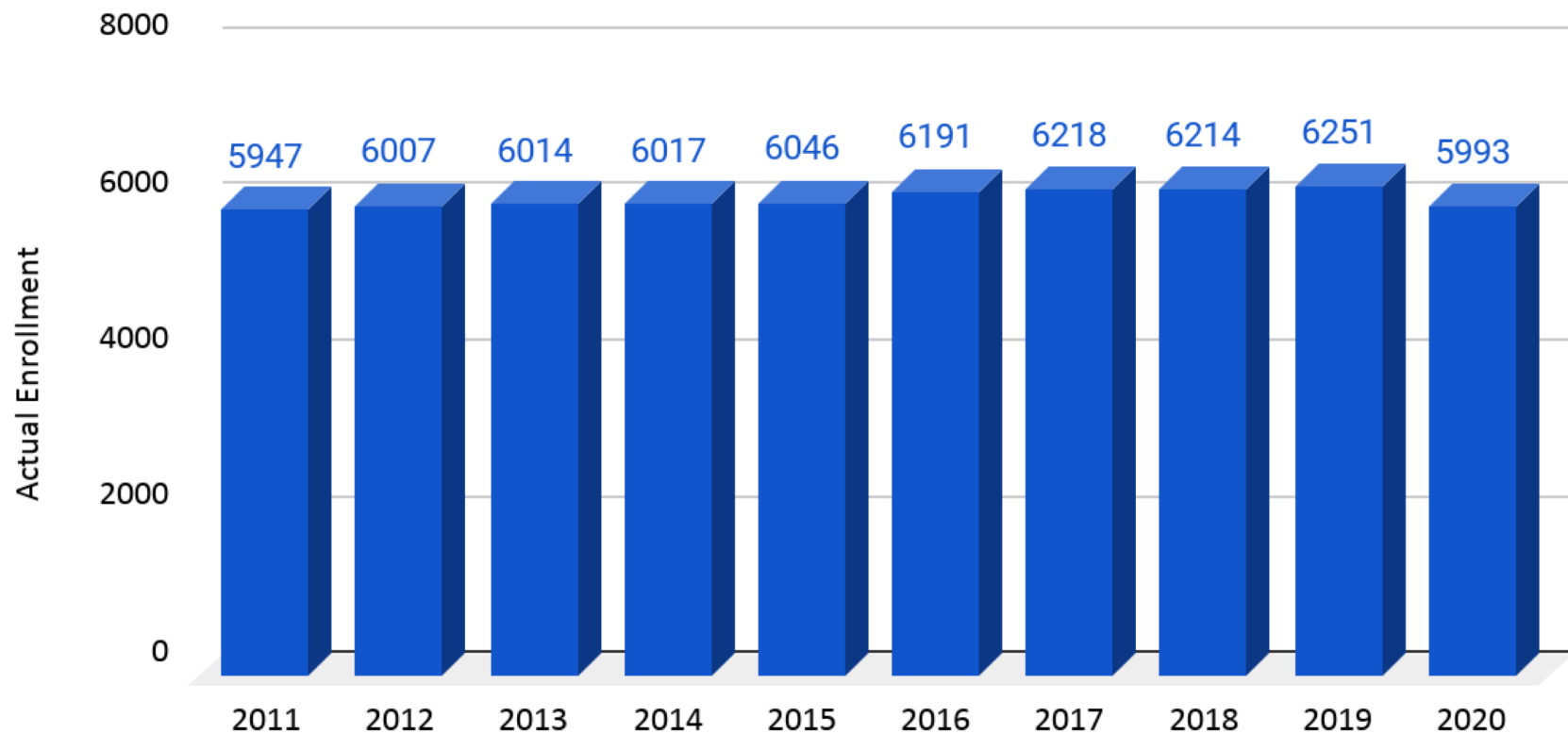
# Key Enrollment Data Points

(35 fewer than last year)

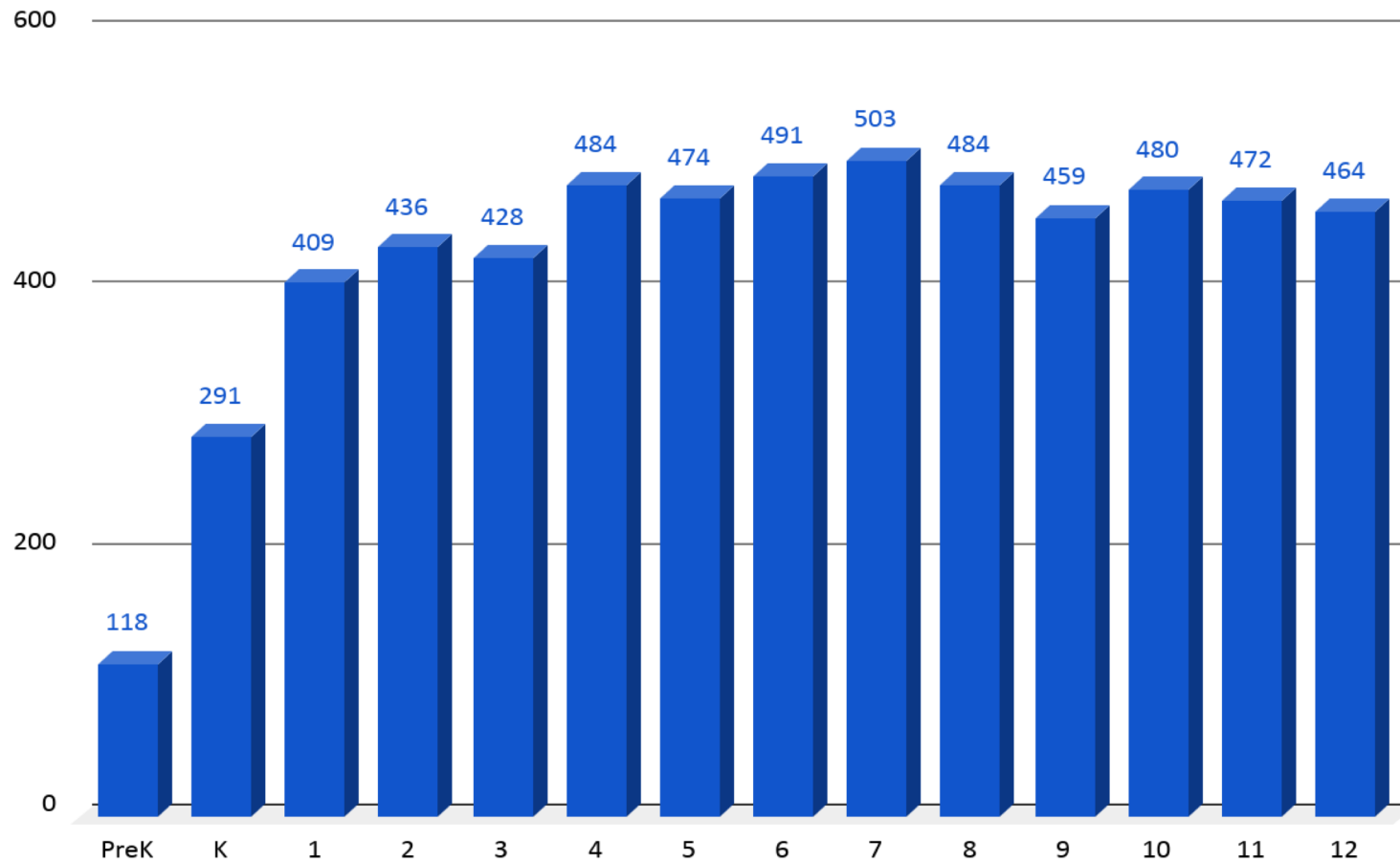

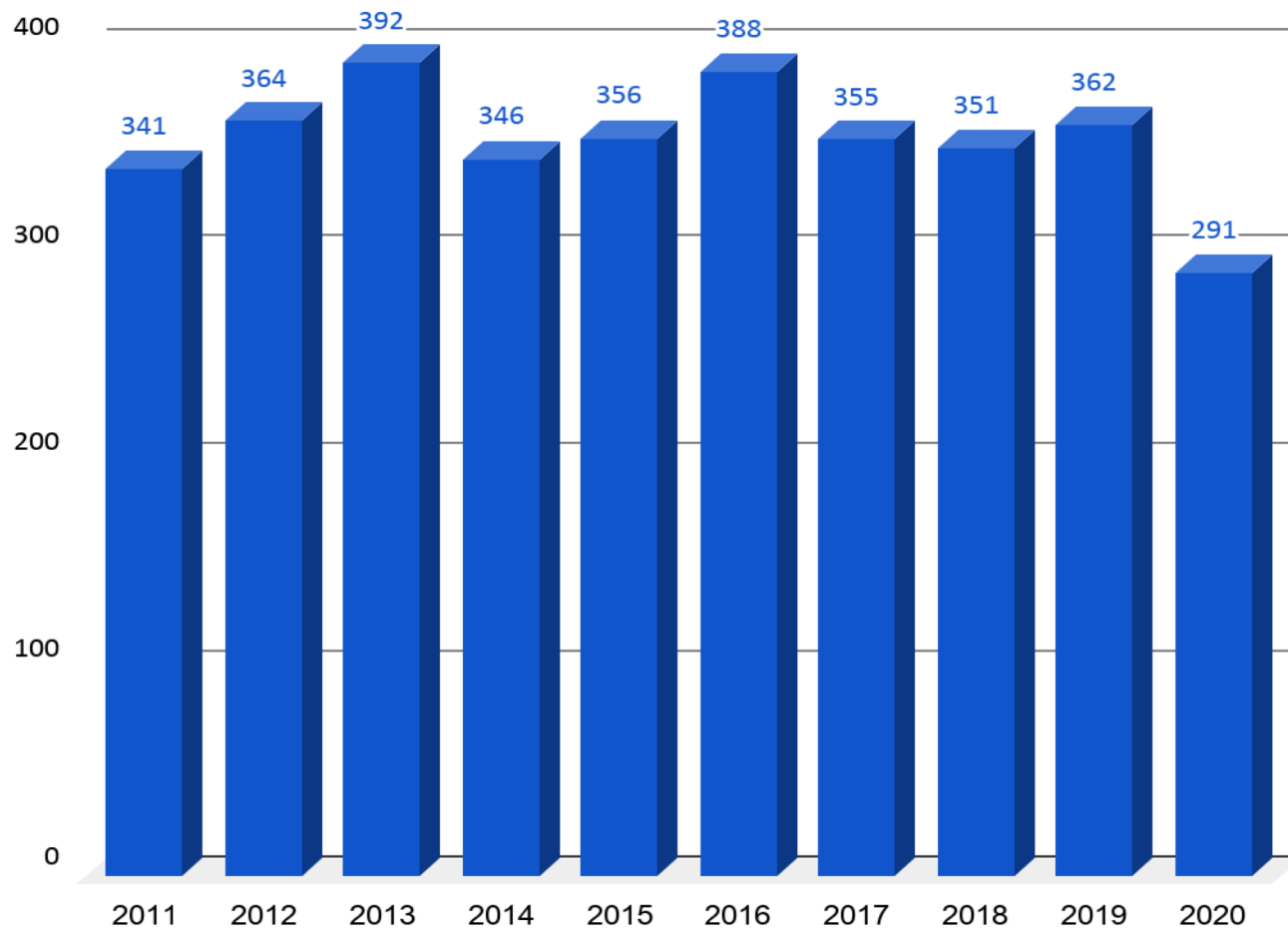

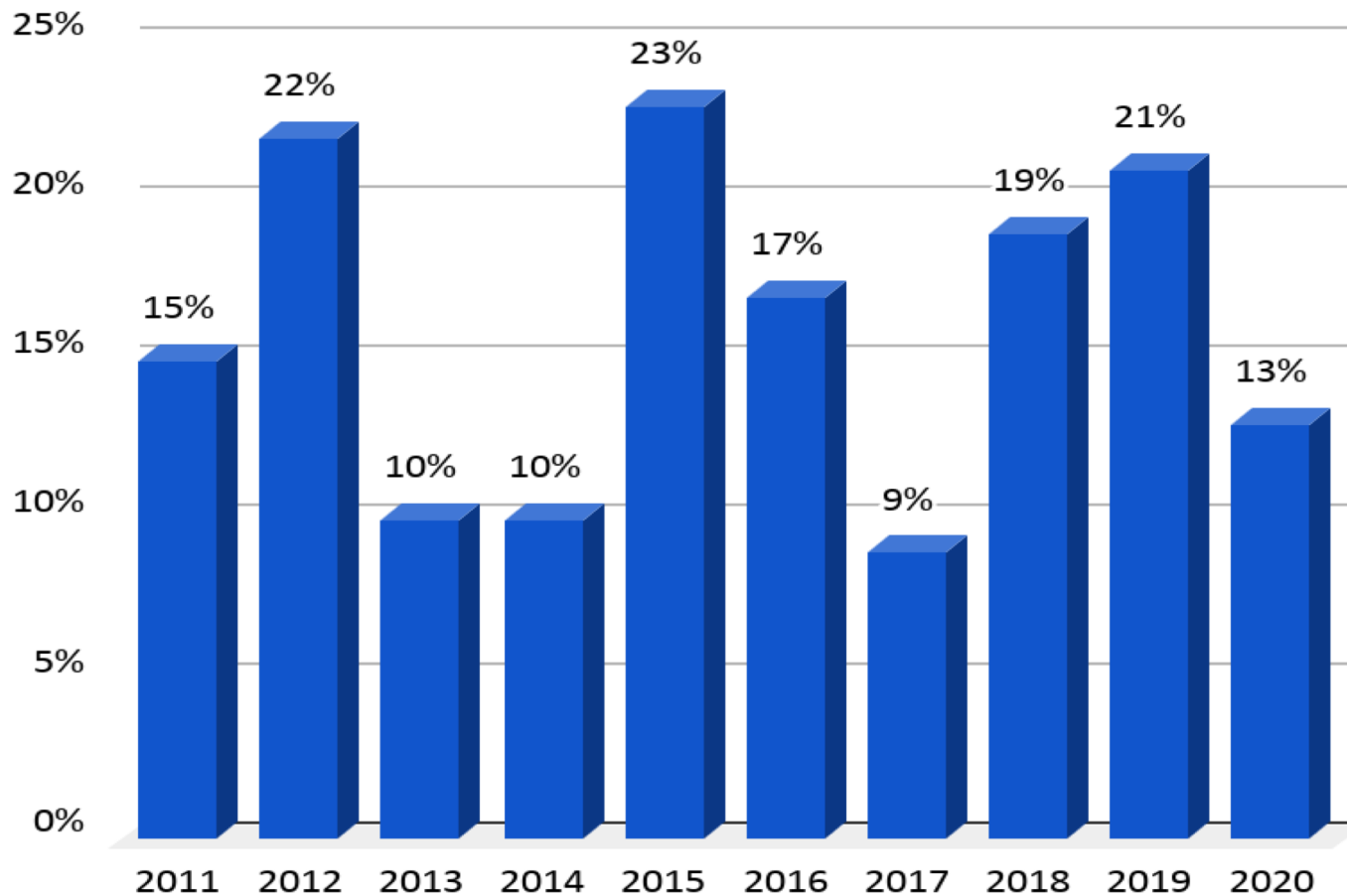

# Increase from Kindergarten to Grade 1



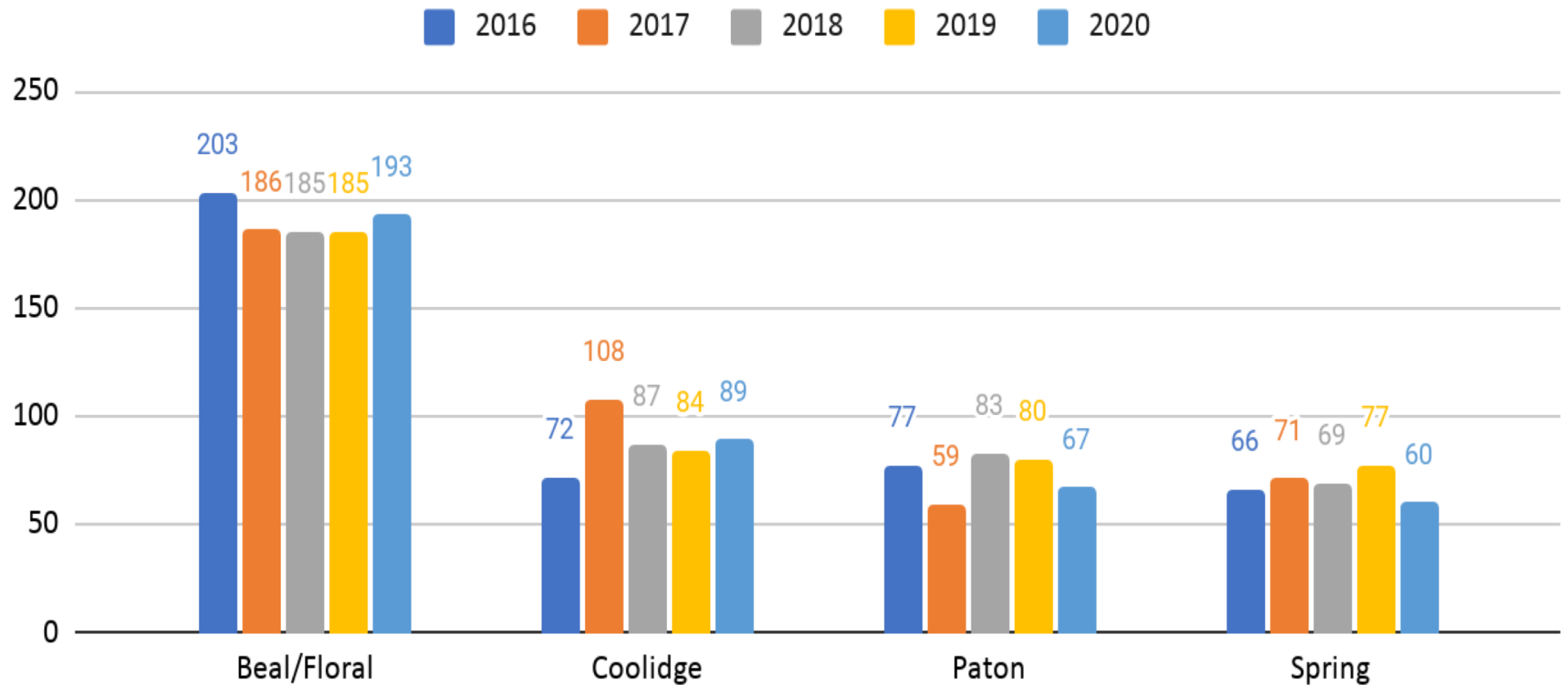
K to Gr 1 Increase

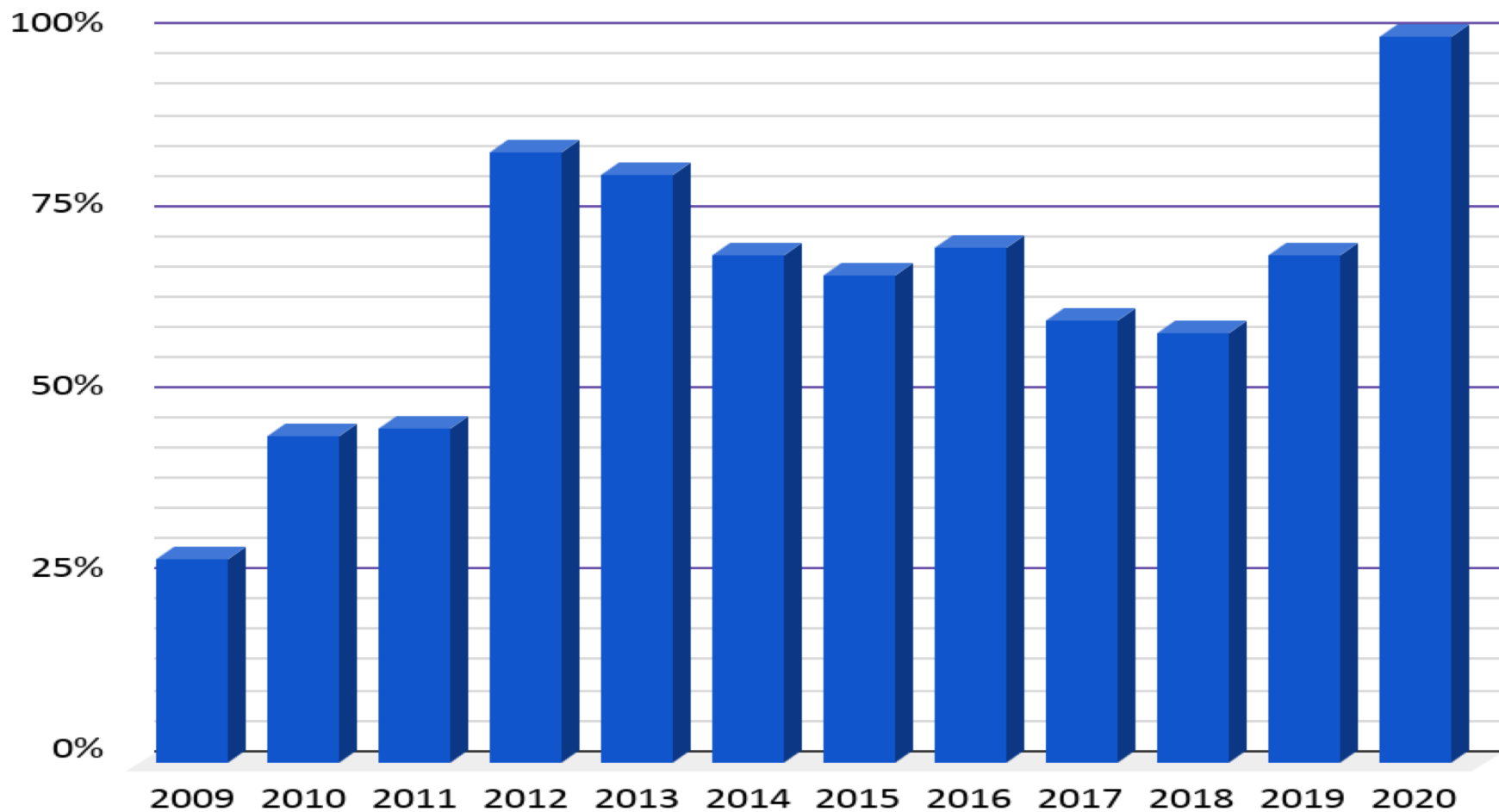

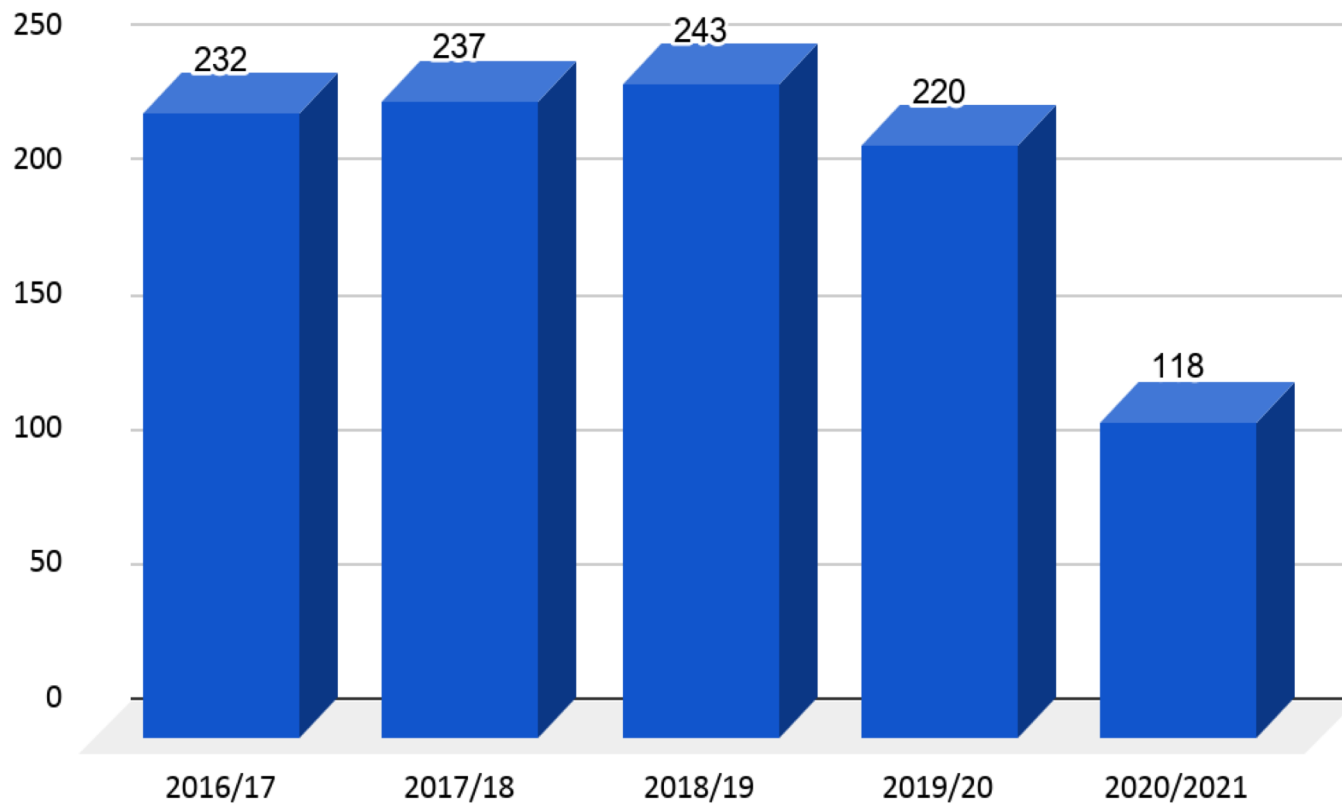

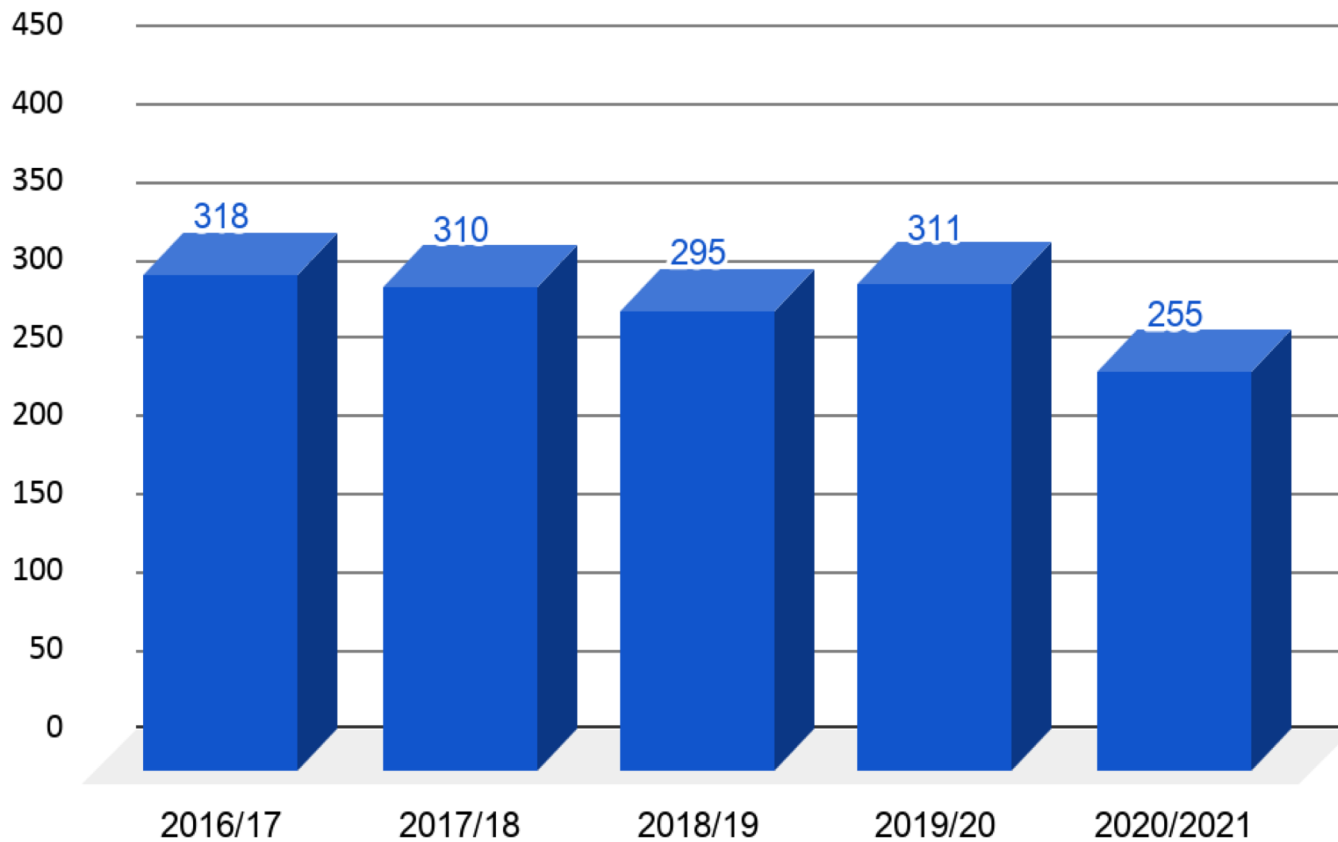

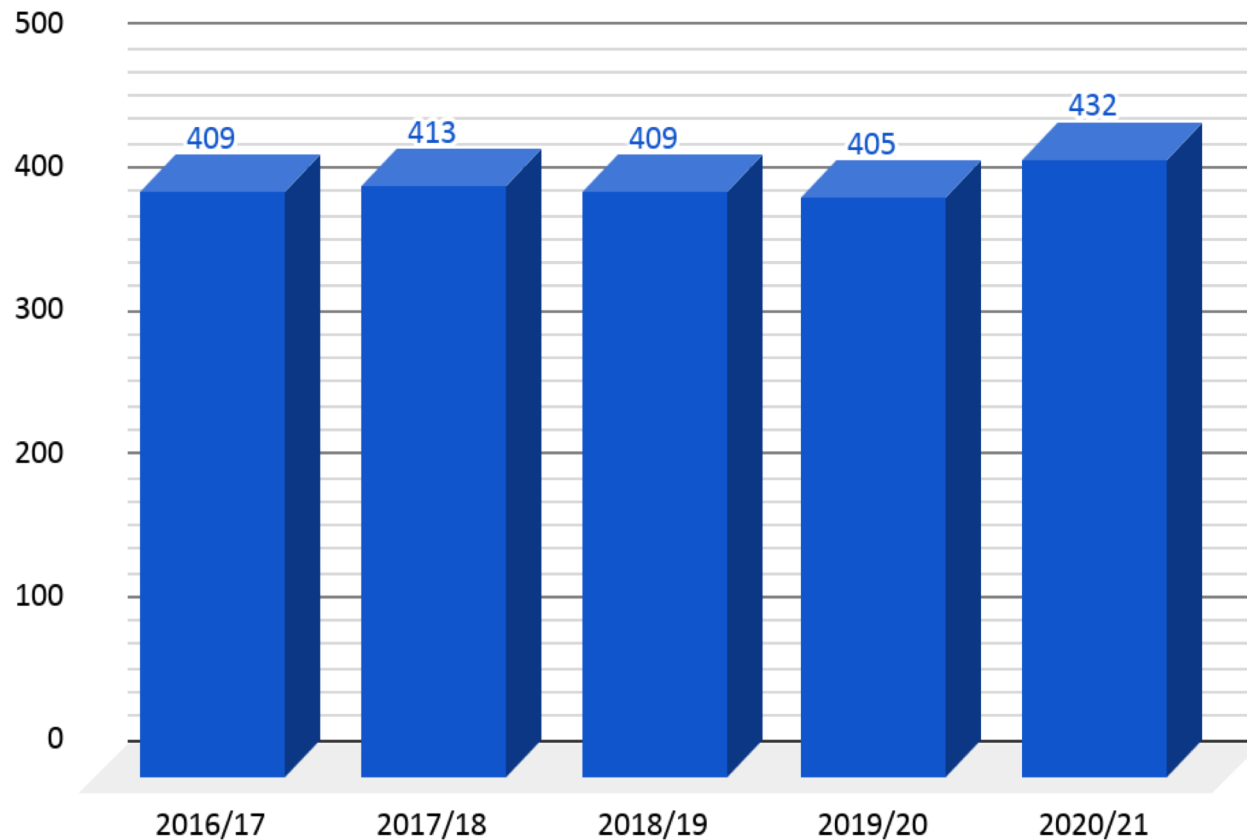

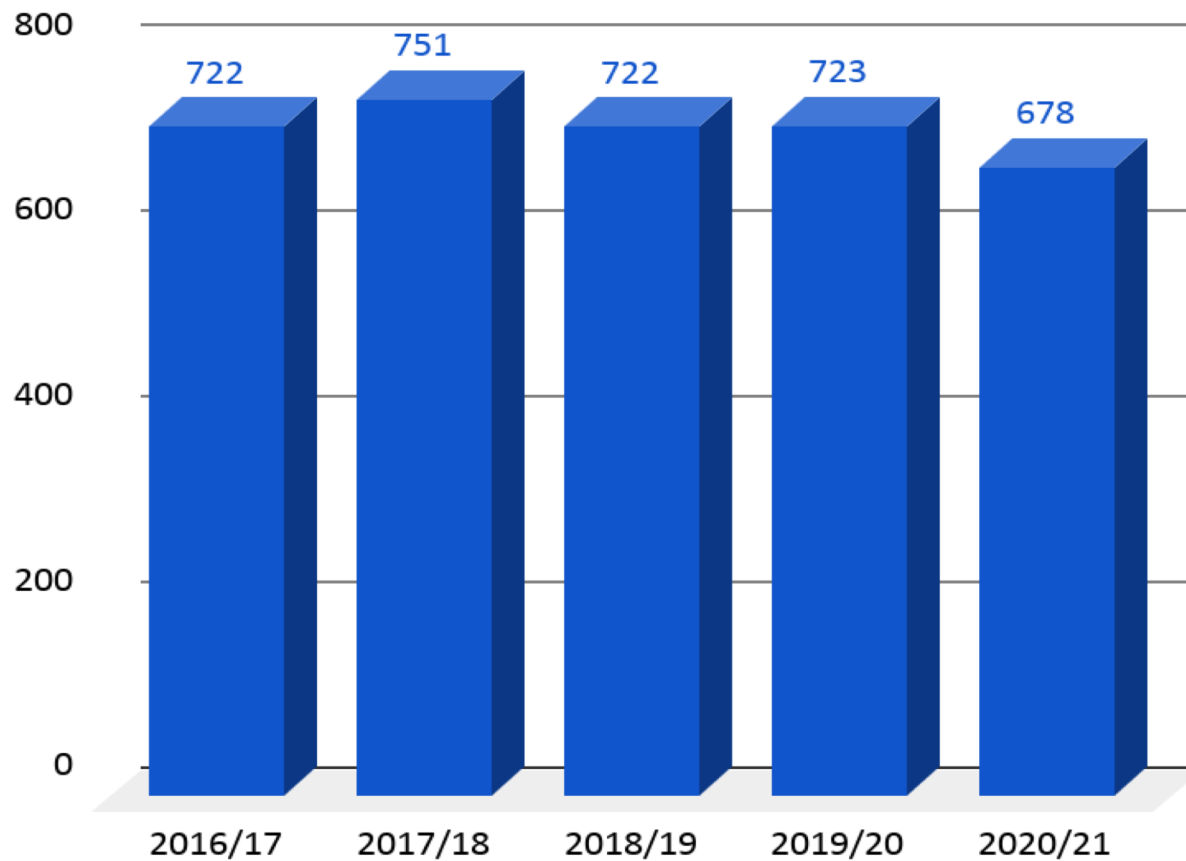

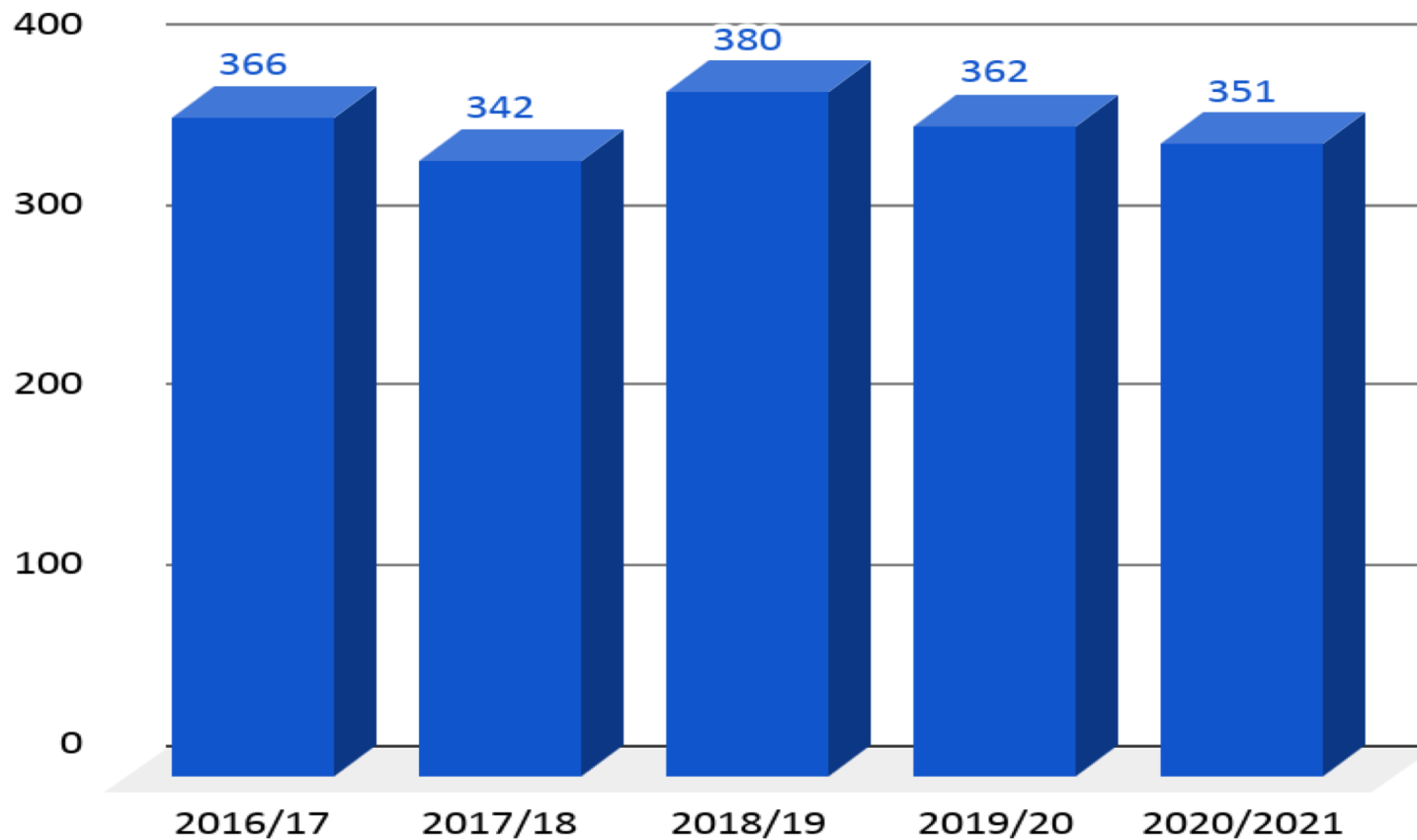

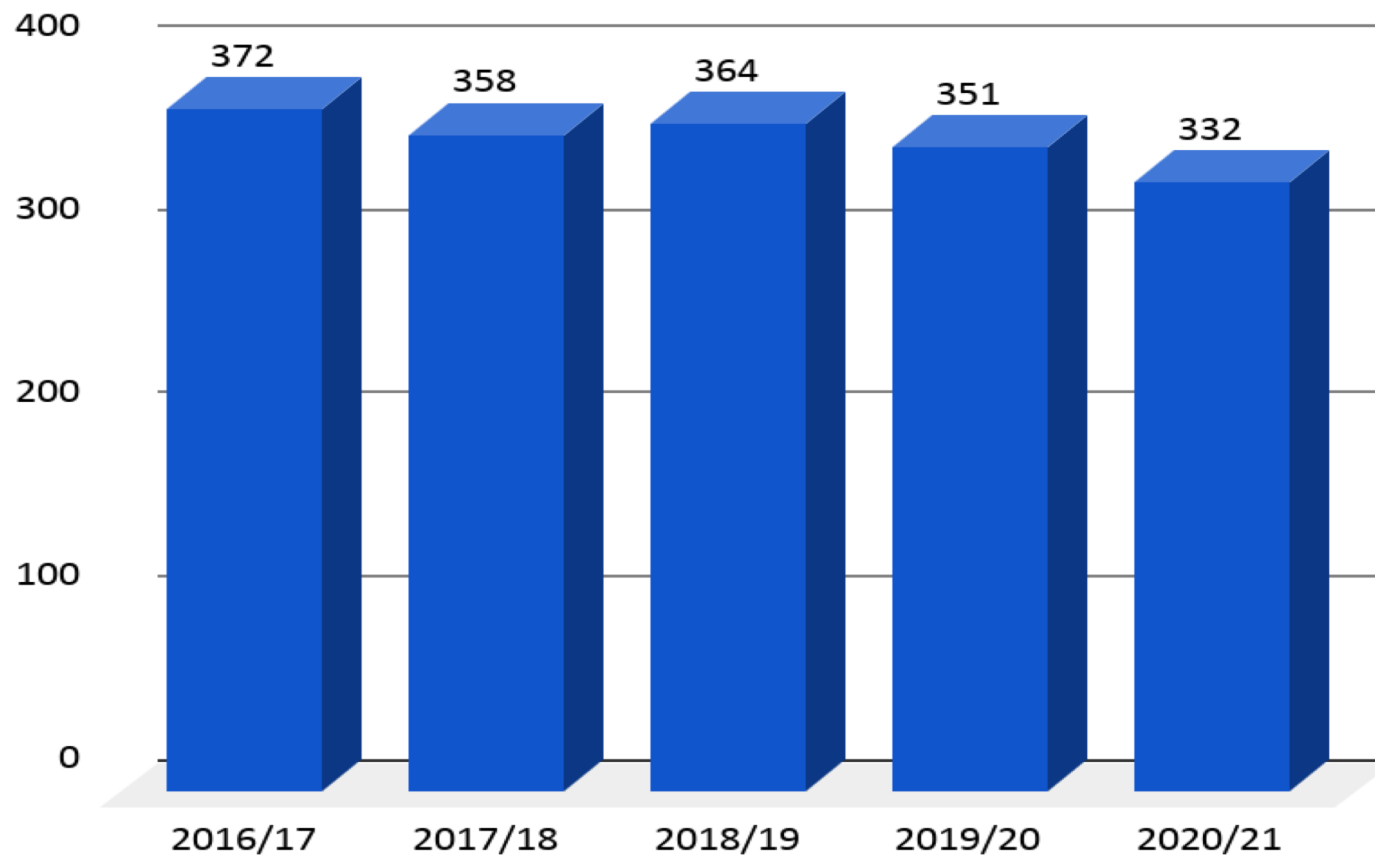

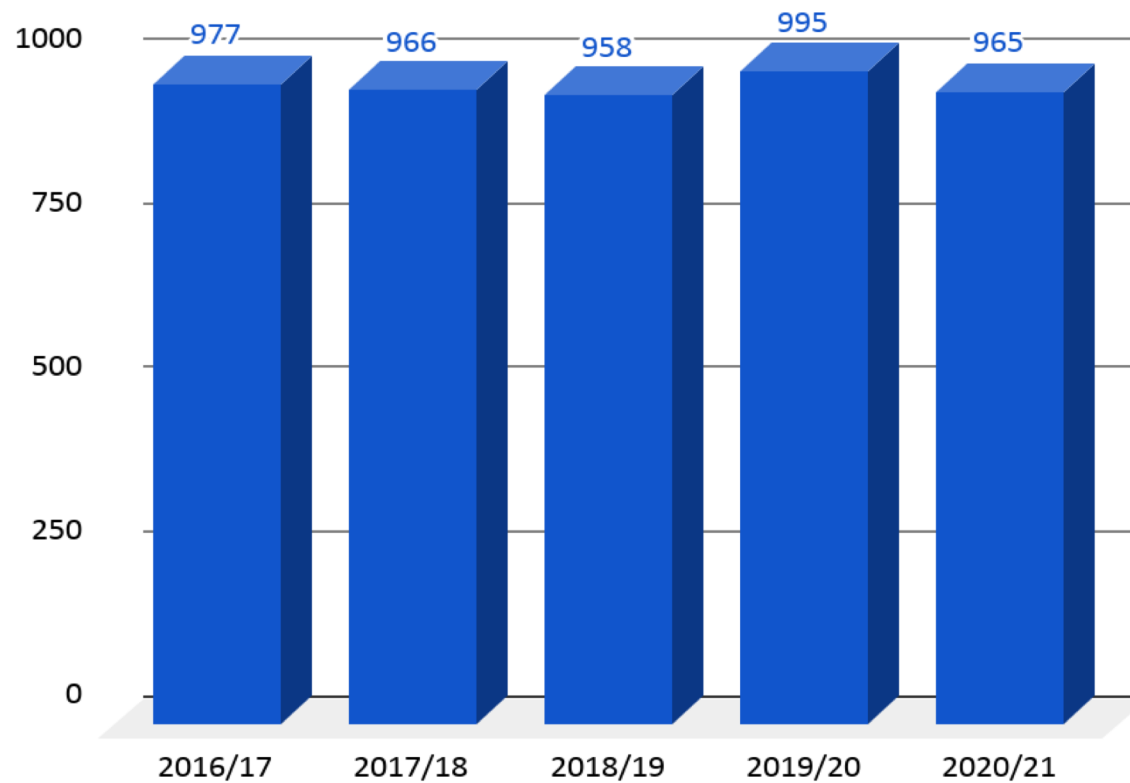

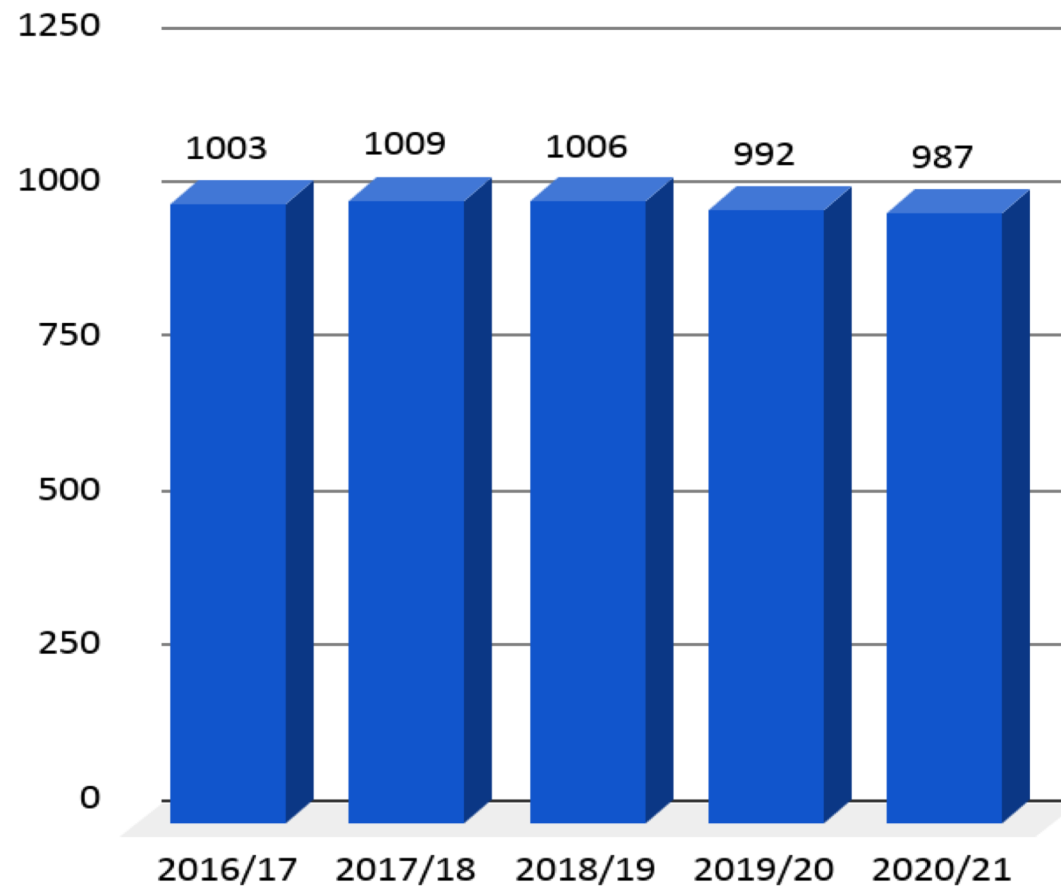

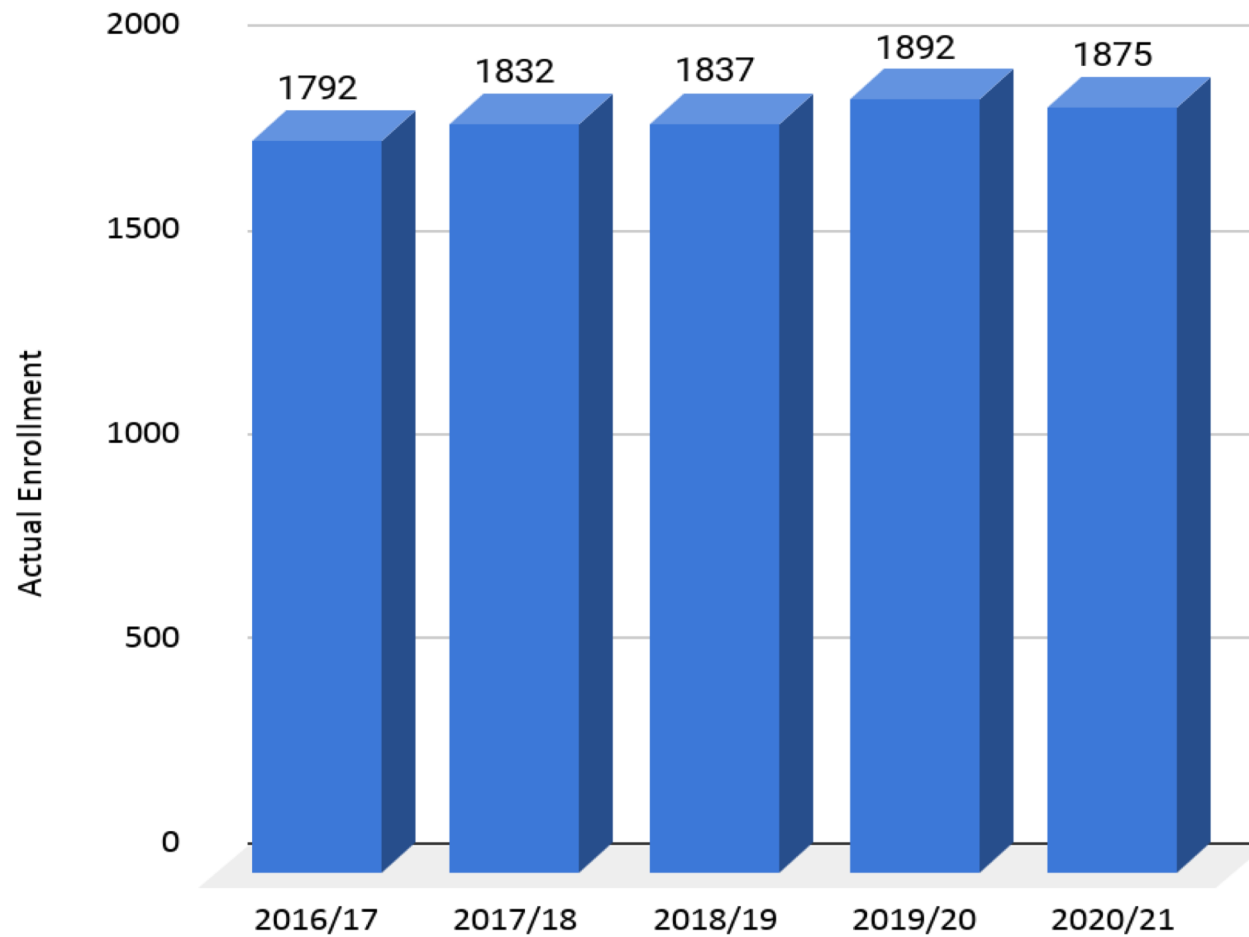

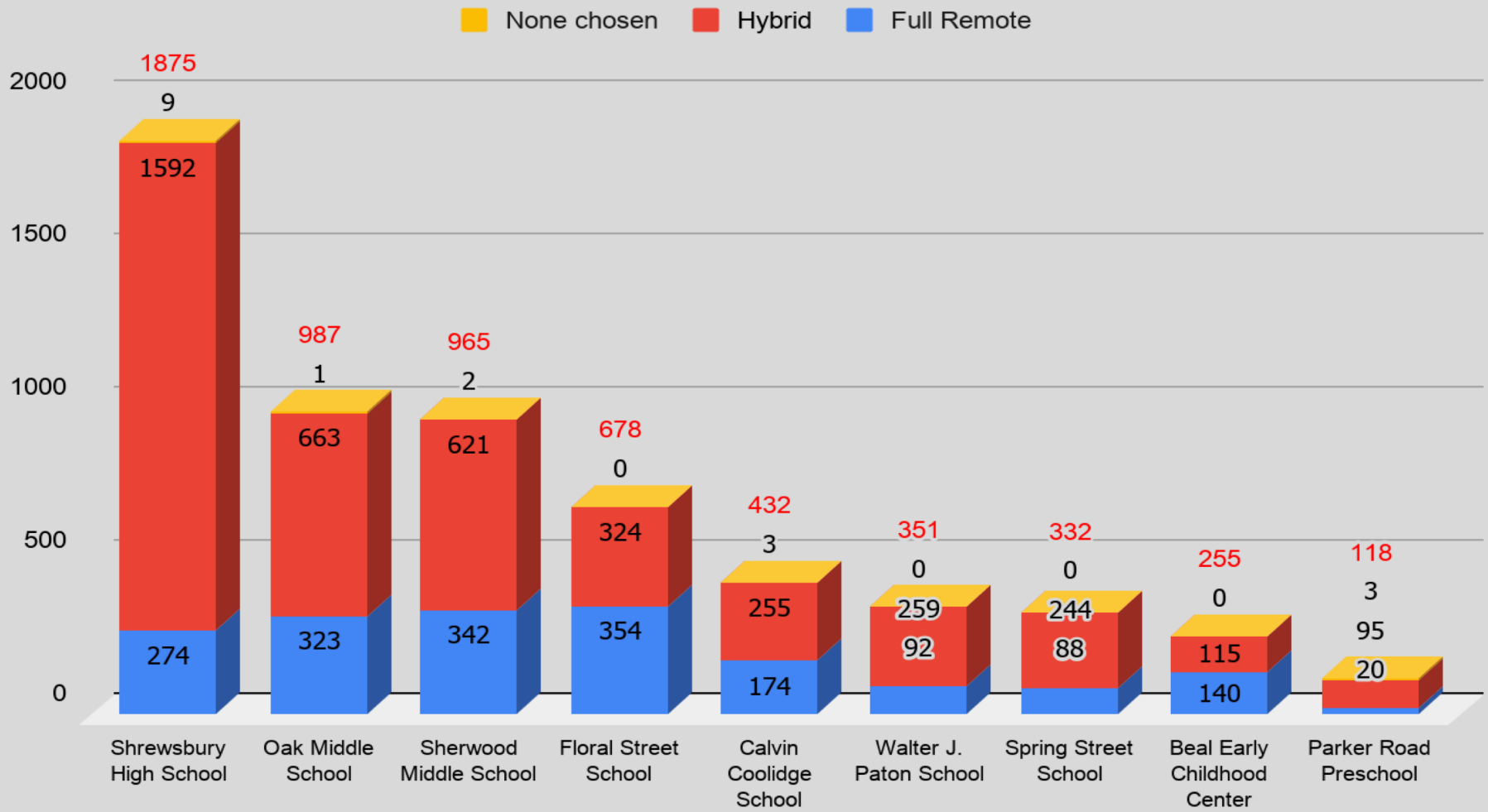

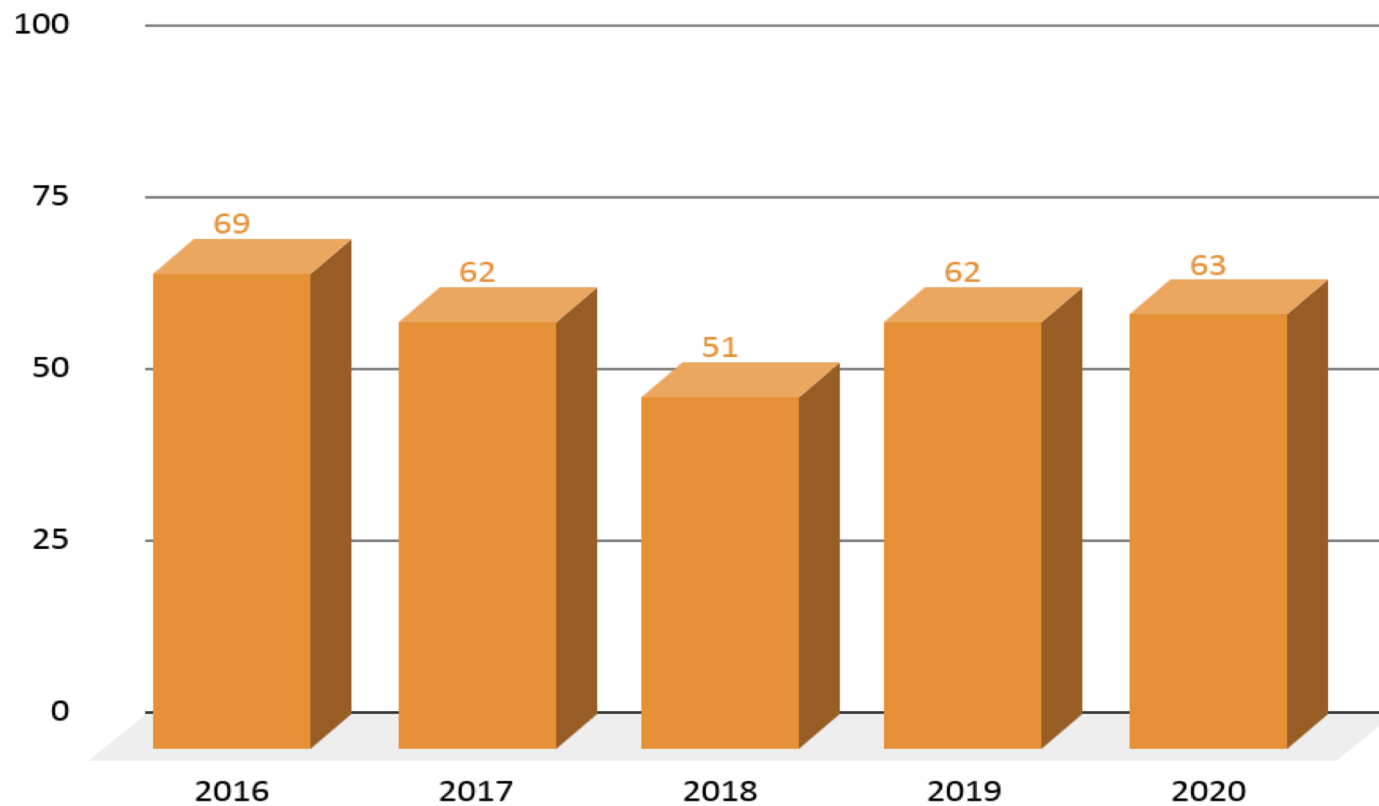

## Special Ed / Out of District Placement



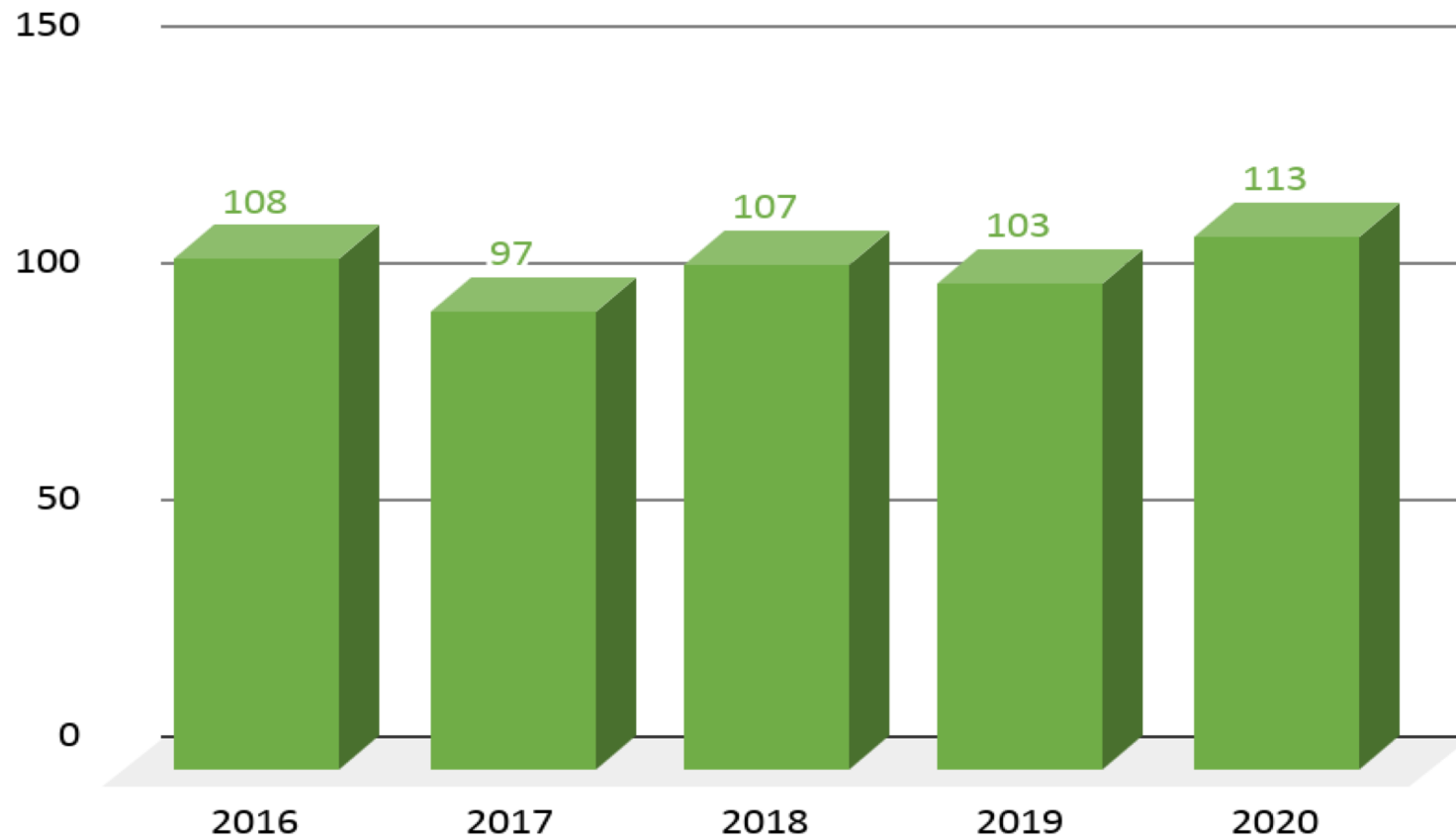

# School Committee Class Size Guidelines



- Kindergarten: 17 - 19 students
  - Overenrolled = 22 or more
- Grades 1 & 2: 20 - 22 students
  - Overenrolled = 25 or more
- Grades 3 - 8: 22-24 students
  - Overenrolled = 27 or more
- Grades 9 - 12: 18-20 students
  - (not including large classes in music and PE)
  - Overenrolled = 27 or more (24 for science labs)
