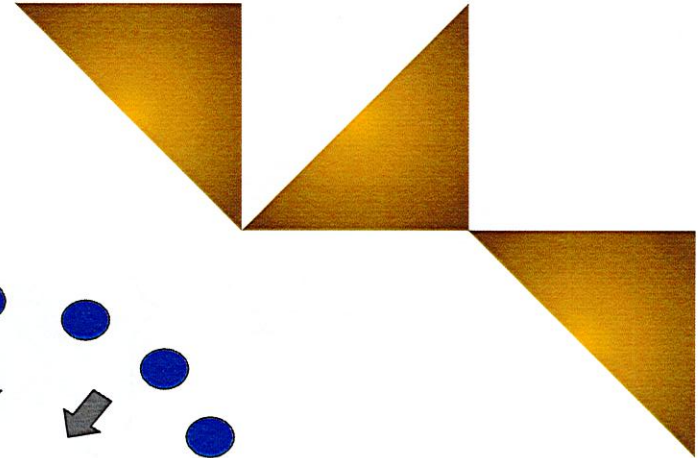
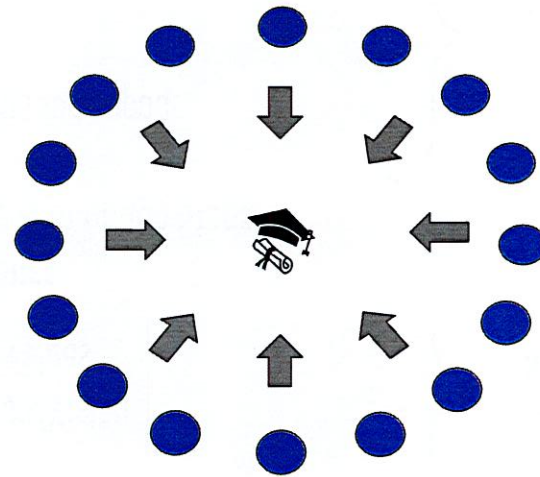
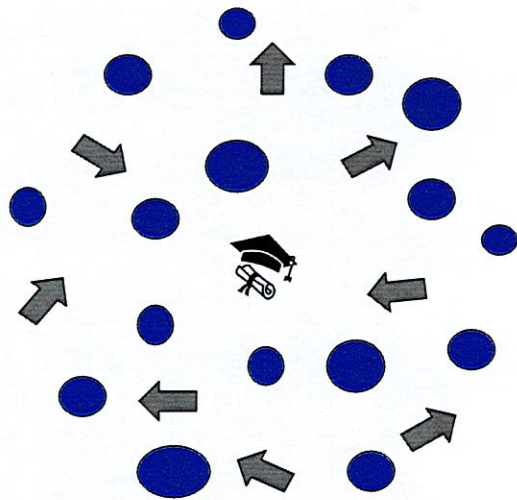


SHREWSBURY PUBLIC SCHOOLS PORTRAIT OF A GRADUATE

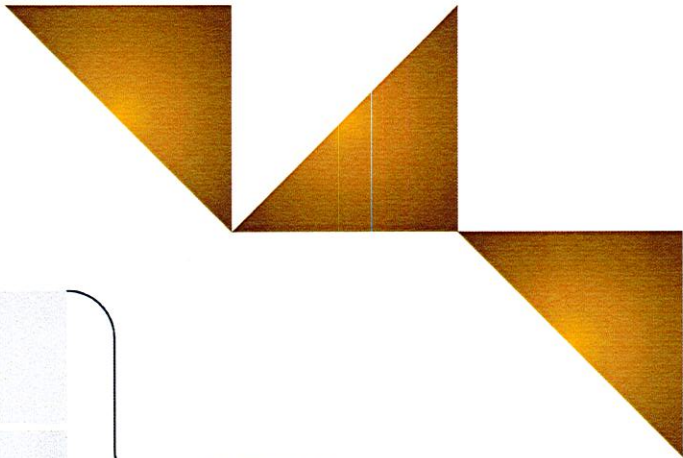
