Focused Schools - Strategic Priorities

The School Committee was briefed on the Strategic Priorities draft presented by consultants from Focused Schools. School Committee members collaborated with the Central Office Leadership Team to review the draft and provided feedback for future revisions.

FY 24 Budget - Update

Mr. Collins provided an update regarding the FY 24 Budget as the overall numbers have matured since our last workshop. School Committee members expressed the importance of investing in literacy resources, if needed, and to pursue additional vocational/trade type programs to mitigate the challenges with vocational school accessibility for Shrewsbury students. Mr. Collins also presented the School Committee with a breakdown of Substitute Teacher expenses as a result of increased sick and personal time usage. The final budget workshop is on Wednesday, April 5th in advance of our Budget Recommendation vote on Wednesday, April 12th.

DECA Orlando Student Trip

The School Committee reviewed a memo from SHS Principal Todd Bazydlo requesting permission for the DECA club to attend an overnight trip to a competition in Orlando, FL. An additional document was provided with trip details and cost.
