

The Statement of Interest Process [SOI]

• The Town of Shrewsbury filed a Statement of Interest with MSBA for a Shrewsbury High School expansion project on April 14, 2023

• 63 Statements of Interest were submitted to MSBA during the 2023 Submittal Period

• Shrewsbury High School is one of about 30 moving forward for further consideration through a Senior Study

Next Steps

October 2023- A Senior Study will be conducted at Shrewsbury High School

• Team of architects from out of state, contracted by MSBA, visit to meet with municipal and school officials in order to examine the school facility and review the Statement of Interest information

~January 2024- MSBA Board Members will review and vote to invite selected districts into the Eligibility Module

Goals for PreK-4 Capital Planning Study Committee

- 1) Create a transparent process to discuss the future direction for early childhood and elementary capital investment.
- 2) Review the LPA|A PreK-4 Space Study and determine the pros and cons of the various preschool and elementary configurations suggested in the study and make recommendations to the School Committee and Select Board for a preferred pathway forward.

PreK-4 Capital Planning Process

- September 2023 Forming the PreK-4 Capital Planning Study Committee
- Fall and winter of 2023-2024 reviewing the PreK-12 Capital Inventory & Improvement Study (aka, PreK-12 Space Study) and discussing options put forward in the report
- March 2024- Reporting to School Committee

Forming the Team

- 2 Select Board members
- 2 members from the Town Manager's Office and Public Buildings Division
- Superintendent
- Assistant Superintendent for Finance and Operations
- Principals from each of the 5 elementary schools and Director of Parker Road Preschool
- One staff member from each elementary school and preschool
- One parent from each elementary school and preschool
- Representation from Central Office Leadership Team as needed

November/December 2023- School size review- neighborhood versus large school discussion

January 2024- developing pathway forward
