Superintendent Compensation - FY 18 Review & Adjustment

Per the terms of his contract, Dr. Sawyer reviewed his compensation with the committee in advance of the new fiscal year. Dr. Sawyer noted that he feels his compensation remains generally competitive compared to other districts, and that he felt that a review of the market would be warranted prior to FY 19. For FY 18, Dr. Sawyer requested consideration for a 2.0% cost of living adjustment, which would change his salary from \$186,813 to \$190,549. Dr. Sawyer also requested a one year extension to so that it remains a five-year agreement.

Dr. Sawyer left executive session at 9:51pm. The committee reviewed the request. On a motion by John Samia, seconded by Jon Wensky, the committee voted to approve a 2.0% cost of living adjustment to the Superintendent Salary with a one year contract extension to maintain a five-year commitment. The committee unanimously voted to approve this measure. Roll call votes were as follows: John Samia, yes; Erin Canzano, yes; Jon Wensky, yes; Dale Magee, yes; and Sandy Fryc, yes.
