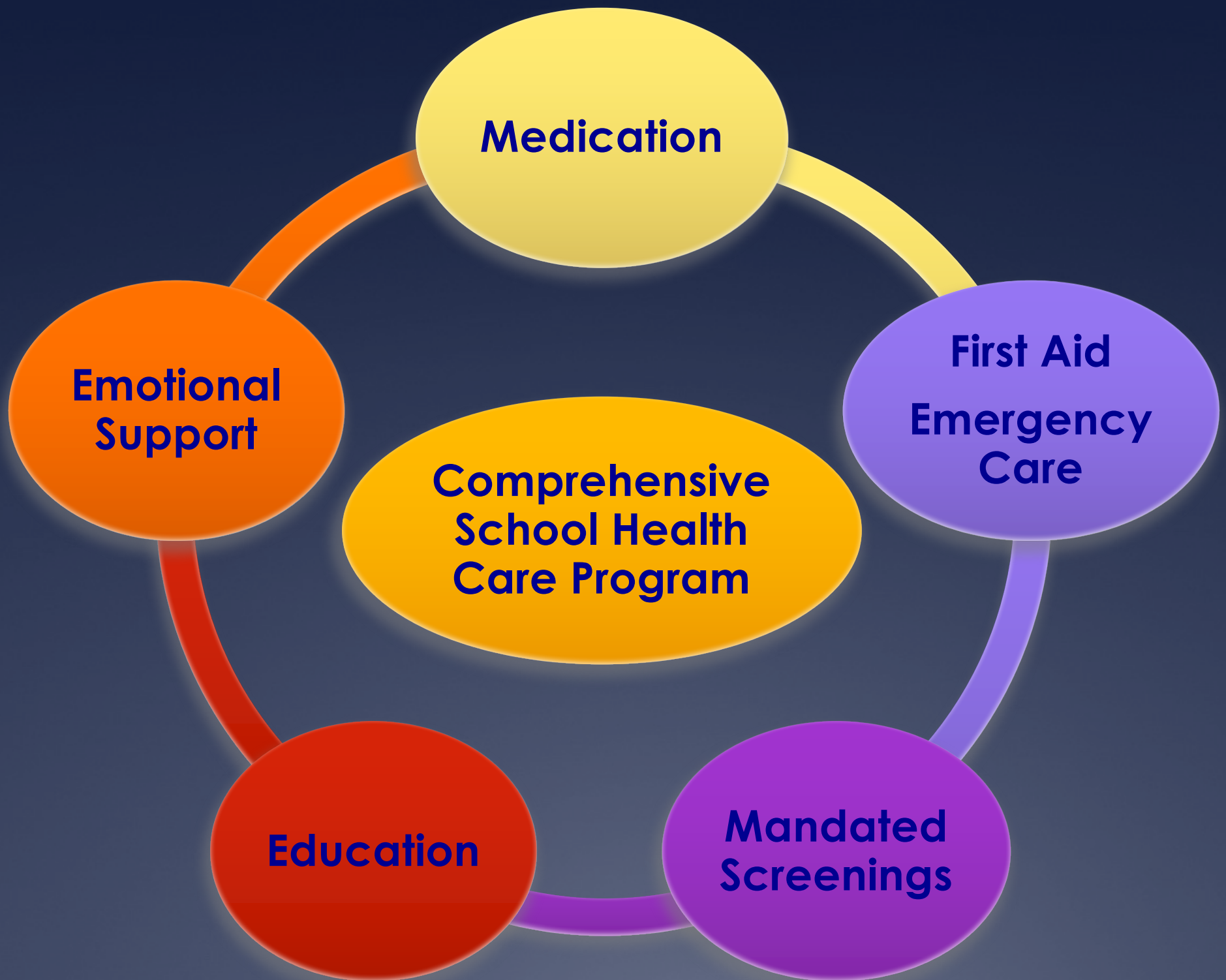

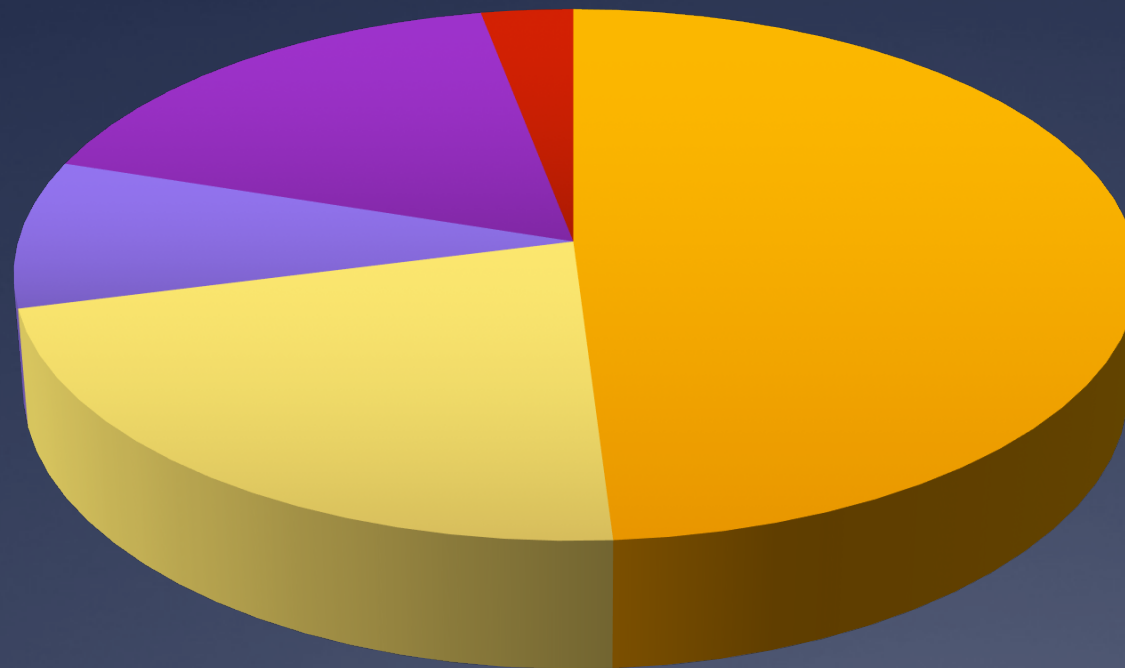

■ Illness = 49%

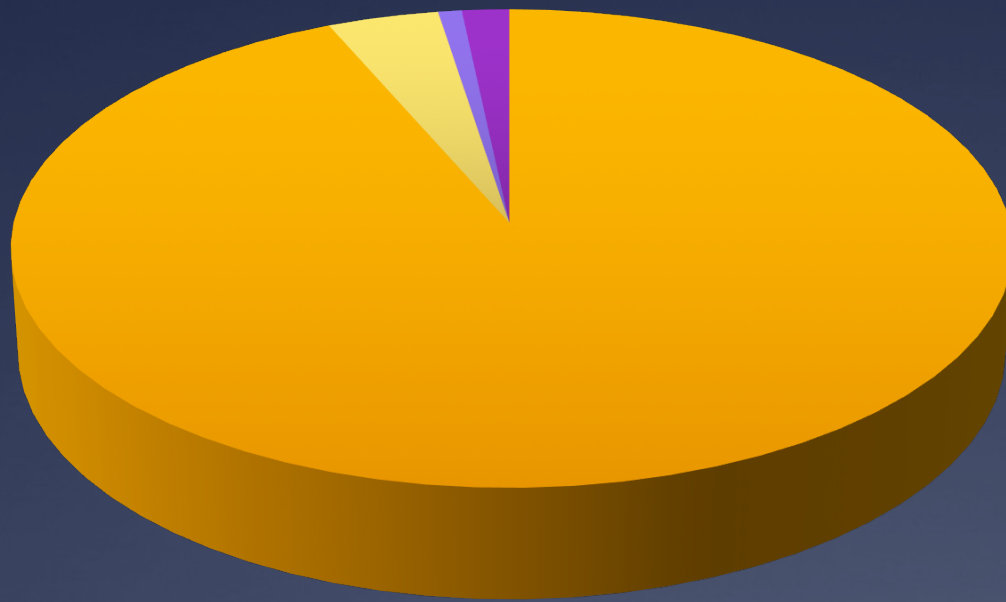
■ Injury = 22%

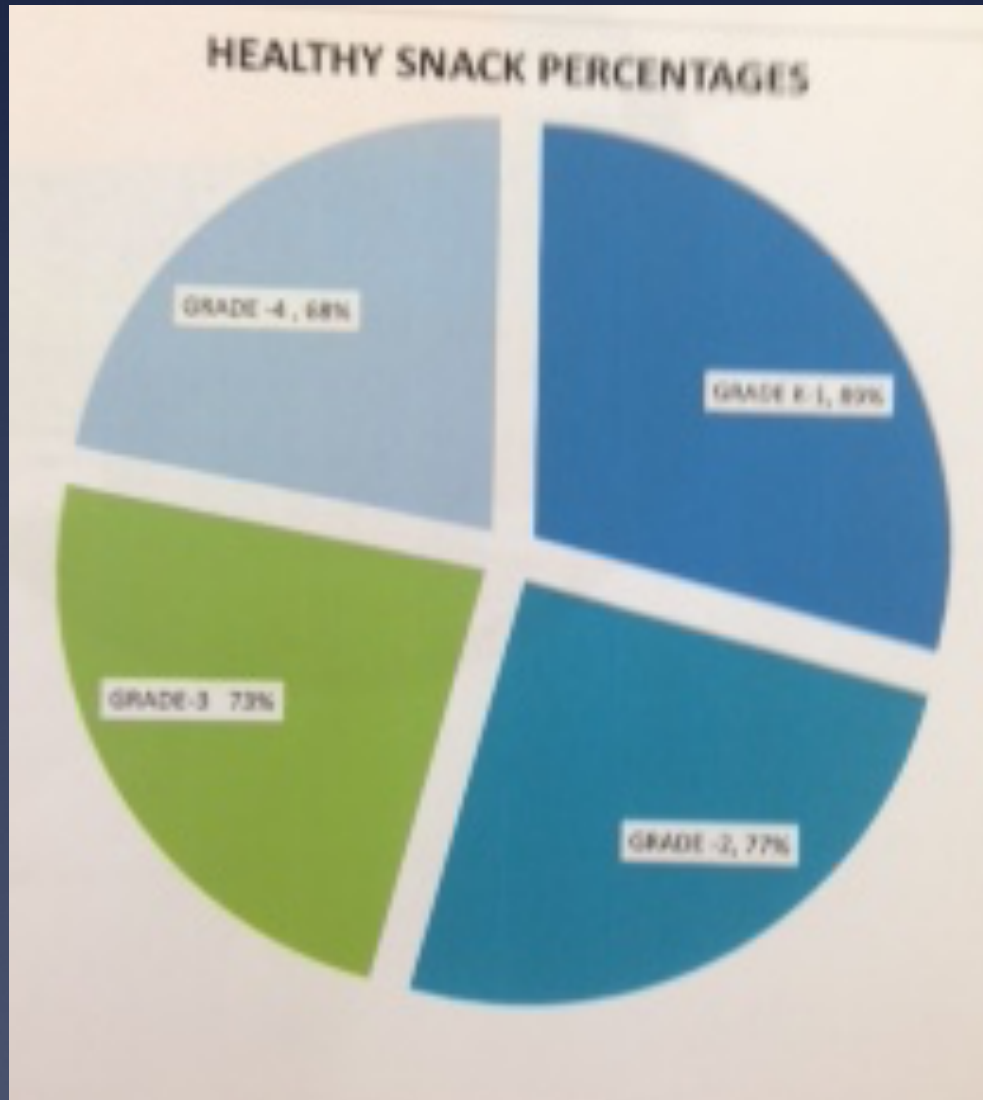

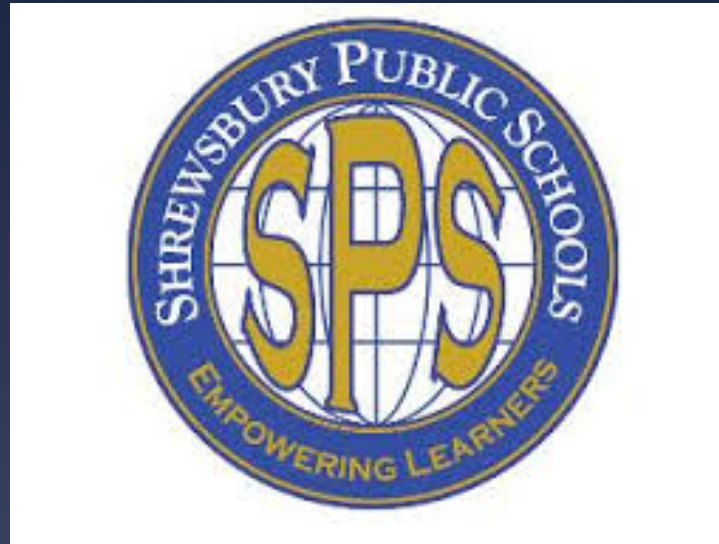

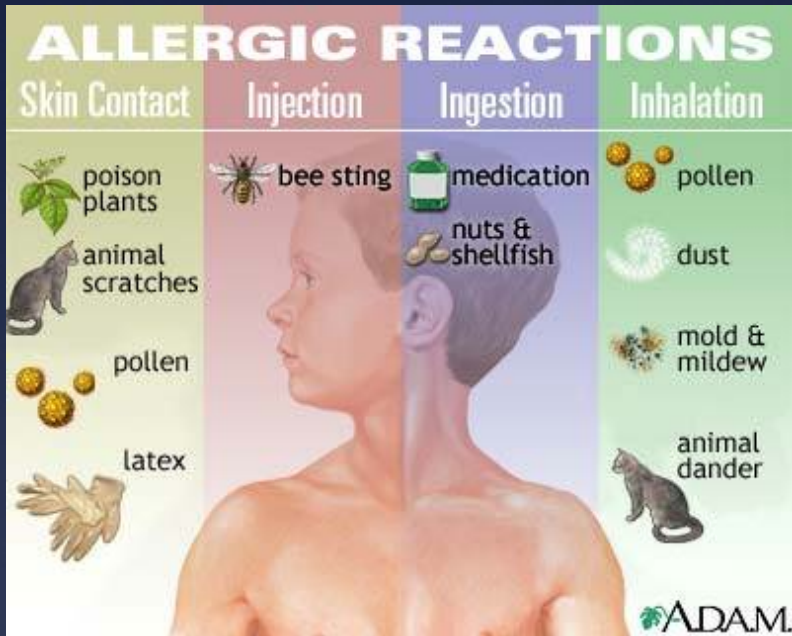

District Wide Updates



Anaphylaxis and EpiPen trainings for teaching staff and administrators were completed at all schools

EpiPens are now stocked in all Health Offices in the district, giving parents the option to not send their own supply in to school



District Wide Updates



58 staff members across the district were certified in American Heart Association Heartsaver CPR and AED skills

2 doses of Narcan (naloxone) are now stocked in every health office for use in suspected opioid overdose



Future Plans

Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) training for staff



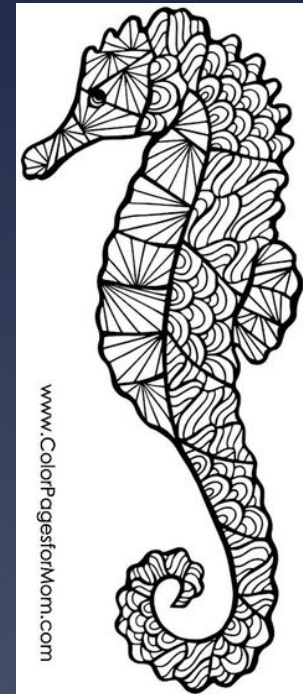
- Screening quickly assesses the severity of substance use and identifies the appropriate level of treatment.
- Brief intervention focuses on increasing insight and awareness regarding substance use and motivation toward behavioral change.
- Referral to treatment provides those identified as needing more extensive treatment with access to specialty care.
