Student Requests Confidentiality	The Shrewsbury School Committee also recognizes that there must be a balance between the students' need for confidentiality and the parent's need to be informed of incidents or situations which involve his/her child in any serious way. In all situations where a student has requested confidentiality, school personnel receiving such a request will:

Serious Situations	It is recognized that only school psychologists have the strict legal protection in cases of student confidentiality.
