


Apple Classroom



Costs over Time

- Texts and Instructional Equipment shifting to software and curriculum development
- Curriculum and Instruction Budget Reductions
 - * FY 15: \$509,929
 - * FY 16: \$444,288
 - * FY 17: Original / 408,288 and Revised / \$326,792
 - * FY 18: Original/\$326,792

Overview of IT Budget

- * Hardware
- * Software
- Data Processing
- Internet access
- * Servers
- Switches and Wi-Fi access points
- Audio Visual Equipment
- Repair and Maintenance

Cost of Doing Business

- * Main sources of increase for FY18:
 - * Microsoft Office Upgrade: \$50,723
 - * Replacing 8 year old obsolete and failing version
 - * Network switch replacements: \$76,000
 - Current switches will no longer be supported by vendor
 - Continuation of iPad leases for incoming grades 5 & 9:
 \$102,510

Maximizing Resources

- iPads of Class of 2017 members have been used for two years
 - * These don't fit into our 4-year replacement cycle
 - Repurpose to upgrade 5 to 6 year old teacher and classroom iPads
