

Mean SAT Scores





Gender Trend: SAT Critical Reading/EBRW





Gender Trend: SAT Math




SAT Participation Rates of Local Districts




2017 SAT Comparisons--Local School Districts Critical Reading and Math Scores Combined








SHS Subject Test Scores Compared to MA and National Scores






Advanced Placement (AP) Courses





AP Exam Participation Rates





% of Exams with Scores of 3, 4, or 5




Overall AP Exam Scores Shrewsbury High School







▶ PSAT


