

Sherwood Middle School Ski Club

Sherwood Middle School will once again be sponsoring a Ski Club after school during the winter season. The program has been very successful through the years and promises to be equally popular this year. Ski Club is not a team; it is group skiing/snowboarding offered at discount prices. It is for all skiers and snowboarders; beginners, intermediate, and advanced, but <u>if you are a beginner</u>, you MUST take lessons.

****Please note that this program is a ski club and not a learn-to ski-program. The majority of our students are experienced skiers and have previously participated in learn-to-ski lessons. We strongly encourage you to make sure your child has learned to ski prior to joining ski club as we are only permitted one adult chaperone to every ten skiers and skiers are expected to be fairly independent while at the mountain.

The Ski Club is an extra activity and will be under strict guidelines. Any student with inappropriate behavior in school, on the bus, or at the mountain will lose their privilege to ski with the group with absolutely no money refunded.

All students who join Ski Club will be *required to wear a helmet*.

The Ski Club will be traveling to Wachusett Mountain on Wednesdays starting January 3, 2024, and running 6 Wednesdays to February 7th, 2024. All buses will be leaving from Sherwood Middle School at 2:35. We will leave the mountain at 6:30 pm and *should* be back at Sherwood by 7:15 pm.

Signups online through Wachusett begin Tuesday, October 24th, 2023.

****Please note that the Sherwood and Oak Ski Clubs are run separately. If your child is in 5th or 6th grade you MUST sign up using the Sherwood Middle School link and code. If you sign up using the Oak link and code you will not be on my registration list and you will not have a spot in Ski Club.

Checklist for registration :

2. ski club waiver/consent to treat form filled out online with accurate contact information. <u>Ski Club Waver</u>

3. *BUS FEE* - The bus fee this year will be determined once the sign ups come in, and a final price can be established. Typically the cost runs around \$100 a student. Bus payment needs to be brought into the main office and given to our secretary Kristen Ward once there is a price established. There will be further communication on the cost of your child to ride the bus.

We are looking to fill two buses this year and will be able to accommodate 100 students. You must register online with Wachusett, using the Sherwood Middle School code, in order to be in the program. The various prices and fees are attached below:



Acceptance will be on a **FIRST COME**, **FIRST SERVED** basis according to whomever first signs up online. After the first 100 students, signups will no longer be accepted online. At this point, I will start collecting names via e-mail for a waitlist.

If you are interested in participating in the Sherwood Ski Club, you must register by

DEPARTURE/ARRIVAL TIMES:

We will be traveling by Silver Fox Coach to Wachusett Mountain in Princeton, which is approximately 35 minutes away. We will depart from the Sherwood Middle School at 2:35, arriving at Wachusett for a 3:20 start. We will depart Wachusett at 6:30 pm, arriving at Sherwood around. All students will be expected to have a ride waiting at the Middle School upon our return from the mountain. Please be prompt as our chaperones would like to get home to their families after a full day of work and mountain fun.

EQUIPMENT DROP-OFF

The Middle School will be open no earlier than 8:05 am on days that the Ski Club meets. No students will be allowed to go through the school with their equipment.

On the days that Ski Club meets, you must drive your child to school with his/her equipment. Ski/snowboard bags are highly recommended to protect equipment. All students with ski/snowboard equipment must enter the school via the parent pick-up/ drop-off door in the Crescent Street parking lot. Equipment should be stored *carefully* under the stairs just inside the door. ALL equipment and bags must be <u>labeled with your child's name</u>. I would even suggest that you take photos of your child's things just in case they are lost or misplaced. Remind your child to <u>only stand up skis/ snowboards that are in bags</u>. All other equipment needs to be laid down on the carpet. A chaperone will be in charge of helping students stow their gear under the steps each Wednesday morning. I would recommend that students wear their ski jackets to school that day and bring any other appropriate winter clothing in a separate bag that they can store with their skis/snowboard.

APPLICATION CHANGES, DROP-OUTS, AND INJURIES

There is a \$10 clerical fee for changes made after the application is received by Wachusett Mountain. To withdraw from the program, I would need the Student Badge/Pass along with a withdrawal letter from the parent.. (If injured, the mountain requires a note from the doctor stating the date of the injury.) The mountain issues a transferable credit on sessions not attended.

Please Note: THERE ARE NO CASH REFUNDS IF YOU DID NOT PURCHASE THE BADGE/PASS INSURANCE.

Any changes after the applications have been filed with the mountain are required to go through me for processing.

LOST & FORGOTTEN BADGES AND PASSES

Forgetting or Replacing a Student Badge is \$15 if Badge/Pass Insurance has not been purchased at time of purchase. Forgetting a Season Pass will cost the price of a lift ticket and Replacing a Season Pass is \$15 if Badge/Pass Insurance has not been purchased at time of purchase.

BEHAVIOR

Any student found drinking, stealing, in the possession of a controlled substance or cigarettes, using vulgarities, skiing or snowboarding in a reckless manner, or anything else that in management's or the school's opinion is considered disruptive, dangerous or illegal will be dismissed from the program WITHOUT a refund and will possibly be banned from the area (Wachusett Mountain) for the remainder of the season.

Students will also be responsible for making it to the bus on time. This applies for getting to the bus at school, and leaving the mountain. If a student holds up the bus leaving the mountain, they will not be permitted to ski the next week.

CHAPERONES

If you are interested in volunteering as a chaperone during the ski club this season, please send me a message via e-mail at <u>tangell@shrewsbury.k12.ma.us</u> All chaperones are required to have a current CORI on file with Central Office. Volunteers will be considered on a first come, first served basis.

It is preferred that chaperones take the bus with us from Sherwood, and ride back on the bus as well.

CANCELLATION

If school is canceled, we will automatically cancel ski club. If Oak Middle School cancels their ski club, we will also cancel and vice versa. If we cancel due to snow after school has already started, a decision will be made by 12 noon. Please call the school to check, or make arrangements with your son/daughter to contact you from school just to be sure. I will do everything in my power to send out an email as soon as I know that we will be canceling the ski club that day, but it will depend on my class schedule and availability to do so.
